

The GOLDEN FAST

A. SCRIPTURES regarding WORDS

1. PROVERBS 10:19-20a

In the multitude of words there wanteth not sin: but he that refraineth his lips *is* wise. ²⁰ The tongue of the just *is as* choice silver:

2. ECCLESIASTES 5:2, 3b, 6a, 7

² Be not rash with thy mouth, and let not thine heart be hasty to utter *any* thing before God: for God *is* in heaven, and thou upon earth: therefore let thy words be few.

a fool's voice is known by multitude of words.

⁶ Suffer not thy mouth to cause thy flesh to sin;

⁷ For in the multitude of dreams and many words *there are* also *divers* vanities: but fear thou God.

3. PROVERBS 13:3

He that keepeth his mouth keepeth his life: *but* he that openeth wide his lips shall have destruction.

4. PROVERBS 6:2

thou art snared with the words of thy mouth, thou art taken with the words of thy mouth.

5. MARK 11:23

For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith.



6. PROVERBS 17:27-28

He that hath knowledge spareth his words: and a man of understanding is of an excellent spirit. ²⁸ Even a fool, when he holdeth his peace, is counted wise: and he that shutteth his lips *is esteemed* a man of understanding.

7. PROVERBS 18:21

Death and life *are* in the power of the tongue: and they that love it shall eat the fruit thereof.

8. JAMES 3:2, 5, 8, 10

² For in many things we offend all. If any man offend not in word, the same *is* a perfect man, *and* able also to bridle the whole body.

⁵ Even so the tongue is a little member, and boasteth great things. Behold, how great a matter a little fire kindleth!

⁸ but the tongue can no man tame; *it is* an unruly evil, full of deadly poison.

¹⁰ Out of the same mouth proceedeth blessing and cursing. My brethren, these things ought not so to be.

9. PROVERBS 16:23-24

The heart of the wise teacheth his mouth, and addeth learning to his lips.

²⁴ Pleasant words *are as* an honeycomb,

sweet to the soul, and health to the bones.

10. PROVERBS 30:32

If thou hast done foolishly in lifting up thyself, or if thou hast thought evil, *lay* thine hand upon thy mouth.

11. PHILIPPIANS 4:13

I can do all things through Christ which strengtheneth me.

12. MATTHEW 19:26b

With men this is impossible; but with God all things are possible.



B. BENEFITS of a WORD FAST

- 1. Drawing us closer to God, deepening our spiritual life as we are focusing on God.
- 2. Receiving an answer to a specific prayer request.
- 3. Taming our tongues to speak blessings only and learning when not to speak.

C. HOW to IMPLEMENT a WORD FAST

- 1. Set a date and time frame.
- 2. Notify all who live in your household.
- 3. Have paper and pen available for necessary communications with them.
- 4. Do NOT be distracted by phone nor doorbell nor TV nor computer.
- 5. For longer Word Fasts, it is okay to spend some of the time praying affirmations and in tongues.
- 6. Start small and increase one step at a time.
