

ABC LIFE LESSONS STUDY OF “WAR ROOM” MOVIE Questions & Answers Bible Study – Part 2 All scriptures are NKJV

Question 9: In the scene of Tony and Elizabeth arguing in the kitchen, what was the main sin committed that brought strife into their home and affected their daughter? What scripture could go along with your answer?

Answer 9: Pride

Scripture: Proverbs 28:25 - He that is of a proud heart stirreth up **strife**:

Question 10: What was the Pastor talking about that aligns with our church theme - ABC 6:33?

Answer 10: God is looking for people that will seek Him with a whole heart and He knows the difference.

Scripture: Matt 6:33 - But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you.

Question 11: What was Clara's Prayer Strategy?

Answer 11: Prayers for every area of her life of what the scriptures say; Seeking, trusting, and standing on the Word.

The weapon is praying the Word. The strategy is using different scriptures.

Scripture: Ephesians 6:17b, 18 - and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God; ¹⁸ praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, being watchful to this end with all perseverance and supplication for all the saints.

Question 12: In the scene with Elizabeth and Danielle sitting on the bed, her daughter Danielle says to Elizabeth, "I think you love me a little bit", because Elizabeth didn't invest personal time into her daughter's life. How do you think the Heavenly Father feels when we say we love Him, but don't spend personal time with Him? What scripture relates to this topic?

Answer 12: Matthew 22:37-38 and John 2:5 are 2 good scriptures to review.

Scripture: Matthew 22:37-38 - Jesus said to him, "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind." ³⁸ This is *the* first and great commandment.

John 2:5 - But whoever keeps His word, truly the love of God ^{is} perfected in him. By this we know that we are in Him.

Question 13: In the scene with Clara & Elizabeth, Clara explains to her that she needs to stop whining and trying to fix her husband. Instead pray and allow God to change him. What scripture relates to this topic?

Answer 13: Phil 2:14-16 and Col 3:13 are good ones to consider.

Scripture: Philippians 2:14-16: Do all things without complaining and disputing, that you may become blameless and harmless, children of God without fault in the midst of a crooked and perverse generation, among whom you shine as lights in the world, ¹⁶ holding fast the word of life, so that I may rejoice in the day of Christ that I have not run in vain or labored in vain.

Colossians 3:13 - Bearing with one another, and forgiving one another, if anyone has a complaint against another; even as Christ forgave you, so you also *must do*.

Question 14: What did Elizabeth need to show towards Tony?

Answer 14: Grace

Scripture: Ephesians 4:29 - Let no corrupt word proceed out of your mouth, but what is good for necessary edification, that it may impart grace to the hearers.

Question 15: We can't ask God to forgive us when we what?

Answer 15: Don't forgive others.

Scripture: Matthew 6:15 - But if you do not forgive men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses.

Question 16: There's no room for God and who on the throne of your heart?

Answer 16: There's no room for God and you on the throne of your heart. God alone should be on the throne of your heart.

Scripture: Exodus 20: 4-5 - "You shall have no other gods before Me.

⁴ "You shall not make for yourself a carved image—any likeness of *anything* that *is* in heaven above, or that *is* in the earth beneath, or that *is* in the water under the earth; ⁵ you shall not bow down to them nor serve them. For I, the Lord your God, *am* a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children to the third and fourth *generations* of those who hate Me,

Question 17: What do you kick the enemy out of your home with?

Answer 17: Using your authority speaking the Word of God.

Scripture: Mark 3:15 - and to have power to heal sicknesses and to cast out demons.

Luke 10:19 - Behold, I give you the authority to trample on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall by any means hurt (or injure) you.

Question 18: What was Elizabeth's roadblock of sins that she needed to repent of?

Answer 18: Anger, unforgiveness, and pride.

Scripture: Proverbs 29:22 - An angry man stirs up strife, And a furious man abounds in transgression.

Question 19: When did Elizabeth take her authority and tell the devil to get out of her house, family and marriage?

Answer 19: After repeating James 4:7 three times.

Scripture: James 4:7 - Therefore submit to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you.

Question 20: What did the devil steal from Elizabeth?

Answer 20: Joy. Then she realized that her joy only comes from Jesus.

Scripture: Nehemiah 8:10b - For the joy of the Lord is your strength.

Recommendations: ABC at 6:33!
