**Questions & Answers Bible Study – Part 3**  
All scriptures are NKJV

**Question 21:** After Elizabeth was crying out to God, praying for her husband and taking her authority, how did God move in her husband's heart as he was at the restaurant with the other woman?

**Answer 21:** He got sick to his stomach and felt convicted for what he was doing.

**Scripture: James 5:16** Confess your trespasses to one another , and pray for one another, that you may be healed. The effective, fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much.

**Question 22:** What started changing Liz's responses and reactions towards her husband when he was so rude and unloving to her?

**Answer 22:** Spending time in God's presence where there is fullness of joy. She spent time in her war room praying for her husband.

**Scriptures:**

**Psalms 16:11** You will show me the path of life; In Your presence is fullness of joy; At Your right hand are pleasures forevermore.

**Colossians: 3:13** Bearing with one another and, if one has a complaint against another, forgiving each other, as the Lord has forgiven you, so you also must forgive.

**Question 23:** What was God showing Tony in his nightmare?

**Answer 23:** Tony was hurting his wife with his ungodly behavior which opened up the door to the devil to cause challenges with his wife, his marriage, his relationship with his daughter, his home, his career, and his reputation; and instead of being her Godly covering and protector as the High Priest of their home, he became the his own enemy by opposing himself with self-sabotage and giving place to the sins of the lust of the eyes, the lust of the flesh, the pride of life, adultery, theft, lying, and anger.

**Scriptures:**

**Colossians 3:19** Husbands, love your wives, and do not be harsh with them.

**Genesis 4:6-7** So the Lord said to Cain, “Why are you angry? And why has your countenance fallen? <sup>7</sup> If you do well, will you not be accepted? And if you do not do well, sin lies at the door. And its desire *is* <sup>la</sup>for you, but you should rule over it.”

**Ephesians 5:23** For the husband is the head of the wife even as Christ is the head of the church, his body, and is himself its Savior.

**2 Tim 2:24-25** And the servant of the Lord must not strive; but be gentle unto all men, apt to teach, patient,<sup>25</sup> In meekness instructing those that oppose themselves; if God peradventure will give them repentance to the acknowledging of the truth;

**1 John 2:16** For all that *is* in the world - the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life — is not of the Father but is of the world.

**Proverbs 16:18** Pride goes before destruction, And a haughty spirit before a fall.

**Luke 12:15** And He said to them, “Take heed and beware of covetousness, for one’s life does not consist in the abundance of the things he possesses.”

**Ephesians 4:2** Be angry, and do not sin: do not let the sun go down on your wrath.

**Question 24:** What changed Tony's heart towards his wife that led him to repentance?

**Answer 24:** What changed Tony’s heart towards his wife that led him to repentance:

1. Elizabeth’s prayers.
2. Being humbled because he got fired from his job.
3. Godly advice and encouragement from his Christian friend.
4. Elizabeth’s behavior changed to the Fruit of the Spirit and she humbled herself.

**Scriptures: James 5:16** Confess *your* trespasses to one another, and pray for one another, that you may be healed. The effective, fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much.

**Luke 8:17** For nothing is hidden that will not become evident, nor anything secret that will not be known and come to light.

**1 Peter 5:5b** and be clothed with humility, for “God resists the proud, But gives grace to the humble.”

**Proverbs 27:17** As iron sharpens iron, so a man sharpens the countenance of his friend.

**Galatians 5:16-26** I say then: Walk in the Spirit, and you shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh. <sup>17</sup> For the flesh lusts against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh; and these are contrary to one another, so that you do not do the things that you wish. <sup>18</sup> But if you are led by the Spirit, you are not under the law.

<sup>19</sup> Now the works of the flesh are evident, which are: adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lewdness, <sup>20</sup> idolatry, sorcery, hatred, contentions, jealousies, outbursts of wrath, selfish ambitions, dissensions, heresies, <sup>21</sup> envy, murders, drunkenness, revelries, and the like; of which I tell you beforehand, just as I also told *you* in time past, that those who practice such things will not inherit the kingdom of God.

<sup>22</sup> **But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering (patience), kindness (gentleness), goodness, faith(fulness), <sup>23</sup> humility, self-control. (AMPC)**

Against such there is no law. <sup>24</sup> And those *who are* Christ’s have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires. <sup>25</sup> If we live in the Spirit, let us also walk in the Spirit. <sup>26</sup> Let us not become conceited, provoking one another, envying one another.

**Question 25:** In the scene where Elizabeth and Tony were in their room and he was asking for her forgiveness, where did Elizabeth say her contentment came from that resulted her to be in so much peace?

**Answer 25:** From God

**Scripture: 1 Timothy 6:6-7** Now godliness with contentment is great gain.

<sup>7</sup> For we brought nothing into *this* world, *and it is* certain we can carry nothing out.

**Question 26:** When you put things in God's hands what happens?

**Answer 26:** God fights for you and goes to war for you!

**Scriptures:**

**Exodus 14:14** The Lord will fight for you, and you shall hold your peace.

**Exodus 15:3** The Lord is a man of war: the Lord is his Name.

**Romans 12:19** Dearly beloved, avenge not yourselves, but rather give place unto wrath: for it is written, Vengeance is mine; I will repay, saith the Lord.

**Question 27:** When Tony returned the stolen samples in an act of repentance (even though it was embarrassing to him); and chose to pray and wait on God, how did God help him?

**Answer 27:** Coleman showed him grace and didn't prosecute.

**Scriptures:**

**Isaiah 54:17** No weapon formed against you shall prosper, And every tongue *which* rises against you in judgment, you shall condemn. This *is* the heritage of the servants of the Lord, and their righteousness *is* from Me," says the Lord.

**John 8:31-32** Then Jesus said to those Jews who believed Him, "If you abide in My word, you are My disciples indeed. <sup>32</sup> And you shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free."

**Question 28:** How did Elizabeth's War Room influence her daughter?

**Answer 28:** She made her own War Room in her closet.

**Scripture: Romans 14:19** So then we pursue the things which make for peace and the building up of one another.

**Question 29:** When Elizabeth was showing Clara's home why did the couple buy the house?

**Answer 29:** Because the Pastor felt the anointing baked into the walls of Clara's War Room.

**Scripture: Psalm 141:2:** Let my prayer be set before You as incense the lifting up of my hands as the evening sacrifice.

**Question 30:** What did Clara encourage Elizabeth after she received her breakthrough?

**Answer 30:** Go and help someone else; and help that person become saved as a true disciple of Jesus Christ.

**Scriptures:**

**1 Thessalonians 5:11** Therefore comfort each other and edify one another, just as you also are doing.

**1 Timothy 2:3-4** For this *is* good and acceptable in the sight of God our Savior, <sup>4</sup> who desires all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth.

**Matthew 28:19** Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the Name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost:

**Question 31:** What did Clara want Elizabeth to teach other young women?

**Answer 31:** How to seek the Lord and how to fight the right way with the good fight of faith using the Word of God.

**Scripture: Isaiah 55:6** Seek the Lord while He may be found, call upon Him while He is near.

**1 Timothy 6:12** Fight the good fight of faith, lay hold on eternal life, to which you were also called and have confessed the good confession in the presence of many witnesses.

**Ephesians 6: 17-18** And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God; <sup>18</sup> praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, being watchful to this end with all perseverance and supplication for all the saints.

**Question 32:** When Tony saw Tom (the unforgiving boss) had a flat tire, why did he stop what he was doing to help him even though Tom was so ungracious to him?

**Answer 32:** He told his daughter that is how he wanted to be treated.

**Scripture: Leviticus 19:18** You shall not take vengeance, nor bear any grudge against the children of **your** people, but you shall **love your neighbor as yourself**.

**Luke 6:31** And just as you want men to do to you, you also do to them likewise.

**Galatians 6:7** Do **not** be deceived, God is not mocked; for whatever a man sows, that he will also reap.

**Question 33:** What did Tony do as an act of love just like Jesus Christ at the Last Supper?

**Answer 33:** Wash Elizabeth's feet even though it was stinky!

**Scripture: John 13:14-15** If I then, *your* Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also ought to wash one another's feet.<sup>15</sup> For I have given you an example, that you should do as I have done to you.
