

Back to Basics - Believe and You Shall Receive

Overview: Faith is our connection to all that God has done for us through Jesus. Faith is expressed through our believing – acting on the faith in our hearts. Jesus asked this simple question to Martha after making a profound statement; "do you believe this?" (John 11:26) Believing is the actions of the faith in our hearts. *Hear the Word* \rightarrow *hope is born* \rightarrow *faith takes root* \rightarrow *faith expressed through believing.*

Faith – pistis (G4102) noun - *persuasion*, that is, *credence*; moral *conviction* (of *religious* truth, or the truthfulness of God or a religious teacher), especially *reliance* upon Christ for salvation; abstractly *constancy* in such profession; by extension the system of religious (Gospel) *truth* itself: - assurance, belief, believe, faith, fidelity.

Believe – pisteuo (G4100) verb - From G4102; to *have faith* (in, upon, or with respect to, a person or thing), that is, *credit*; by implication to *entrust* (especially one's spiritual well-being to Christ): - believe (-r), commit (to trust), put in trust with.

A. The Key to the Prayer of Faith is Believing

1. Faith – expectation of the results.
