

ABC LIFE LESSONS STUDY OF “WAR ROOM” MOVIE Questions & Answers Bible Study – Part 4 All scriptures are NKJV

A. Questions & Answers

- **Question 34: What was your favorite part of the movie and why?**
- **Answer 34: Pastor James** - Elizabeth was honest with Clara and confessed that she did not pray for her husband at all; and only went to church sometimes. In addition, when Elizabeth created her War Room and didn't give up even though, at first, it seemed like nothing was happening.
- **Scripture: What scripture supports your answer?**
- **Pastor James' Answer - James 5:16 (AMPC)** 16 Confess to one another therefore your faults (your slips, your false steps, your offenses, your sins) and pray [also] for one another, that you may be healed and restored [to a spiritual tone of mind and heart]. The earnest (heartfelt, continued) prayer of a righteous man makes tremendous power available [dynamic in its working].

- **Answer 34: Self – Reflective**
- **Scripture: What scripture supports your answer?**

- **Question 35: What Life Lesson helped you the most?**
- **Answer 35: Pastor James Answer -**
 1. Create your “War Room” of Spiritual Warfare Intercessory Prayer.
 2. Get rid of distractions.
 3. Go to a quiet room/place in secret.
 4. Focus your heart and mind on God
 5. Realize that you desperately need the Holy Spirit to lead you how to pray.
 6. Lift your needs up to God.
 7. Confess your sins and forgive.
 8. Believe in God's Word.
 9. Pray and don't rush.
 10. Be grateful for God's blessings of answered prayer even if it starts with a small beginning.

- **Scriptures: Pastor James Answer -**
Matthew 6:6 But you, when you pray, go into your room, and when you have shut your door, pray to your Father who is in the secret place; and your Father who sees in secret will reward you openly.
James 4:7 -Therefore submit to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you.

1 Peter 3:15 (AMPC) But in your hearts set Christ apart as holy [and acknowledge Him] as Lord. Always be ready to give a logical defense to anyone who asks you to account for the hope that is in you, but do it courteously and respectfully.

B. Two Biblical Spiritual Warriors Who Are Good Who Had Victory:
Colossians 4:2 Devote yourselves to prayer, being watchful, and thankful.

1. Esther

Esther 1-9

- a. Esther was an orphan Jewess, who became queen of the Persian king Ahasuerus (Xerxes).
- b. The king succeeded King Darius 1 and ruled over 127 provinces from India to Ethiopia.
- c. At the time a number of Jews were still in Babylon under the Persian rule, even though they had been free to return to Jerusalem for over fifty years.
- d. Haman, the king's second in command, wanted the Jews destroyed and manipulated the king for their execution.
- e. Esther was used by God to save her people as she called a 3 day fast and all of the Jews entered in their own version of a War Room crying out to God.
- f. The result was that she had great favor before the King, Haman was hung and her people were able to defend themselves against the enemy and won the battle.
- g. Just as Esther was called for such a time as this, we are called for such a time as this to prepare for the return of our King Jesus by praying more vigilantly in our own War Room.

Esther 4:14 For if you remain silent at this time, relief and deliverance for the Jews will arise from another place, but you and your father's family will perish. And who knows but that you have come to your royal position for such a time as this?"

2. Daniel

Daniel 6:10-23

- a. Daniel was enslaved in exile as a teenager to Babylon where he lived over 60 years.
- b. Because of Daniel's wisdom, knowledge, and handsome appearance, he and 3 other young Hebrews (Shadrach, Meshach, and Abed-Nego) were selected for the training program of serving in Nebuchadnezzar's court even though all 4 of them refused to eat the king's delicacies had found favor and were 10 times smarter than the wisest Babylonians.
- c. God used Daniel to interpret very important dreams of the kings and the writing on the wall when nobody else could. Then the kings honored the God of Daniel.

- d. God delivered Shadrach, Meshack and Abed-Nego from the fiery furnace when they stood strong in their faith and only prayed to Yahweh and would not bow down to any other idol or god.
- e. Daniel refused to stop praying as decreed by the king. He never stopped his daily prayers. He got down on his knees, prayed and praised God 3xs a day in his Upper Room facing Jerusalem, even though the Babylonians tried to kill him because of it. He entered his version of a War Room and God saved him.
- f. **Daniel 6:11** Then these men assembled and found Daniel praying and making supplication before his God. 12 And they went before the king, and spoke concerning the king's decree: "Have you not signed a decree that every man who petitions any god or man within thirty days, except you, O king, shall be cast into the den of lions?"
- g. **Daniel 6:16** So the king gave the command, and they brought Daniel and cast him into the den of lions. But the king spoke, saying to Daniel, "Your God, whom you serve continually, He will deliver you."
- h. **Daniel 6:18-23**
18 Now the king went to his palace and spent the night fasting; and no musicians were brought before him. Also his sleep went from him. 19 Then the king arose very early in the morning and went in haste to the den of lions. 20 And when he came to the den, he cried out with a lamenting voice to Daniel. The king spoke, saying to Daniel, "Daniel, servant of the living God, has your God, whom you serve continually, been able to deliver you from the lions?"
21 Then Daniel said to the king, "O king, live forever! 22 My God sent His angel and shut the lions' mouths, so that they have not hurt me, because I was found innocent before Him; and also, O king, I have done no wrong before you."
23 Now the king was exceedingly glad for him, and commanded that they should take Daniel up out of the den. So Daniel was taken up out of the den, and no injury whatever was found on him, because he believed in his God.
- i. Daniel never ceased to pray and seek God. His close relationship with God became a vital help in time of need. He wasn't filled with the Holy Spirit like you are. So your prayers will have greater impact.

j. **John 14:12-17**

12 “Most assuredly, I say to you, he who believes in Me, the works that I do he will do also; and greater works than these he will do, because I go to My Father. 13 And whatever you ask in My name, that I will do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. 14 If you ask anything in My name, I will do it. 15 “If you love Me, [b]keep My commandments. 16 And I will pray the Father, and He will give you another Helper, that He may abide with you forever— 17 the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees Him nor knows Him; but you know Him, for He dwells with you and will be in you.

Recommendations:

- Become a stronger Spiritual Warrior God that has called you to be!
- Fight the right way with the good fight of faith using the Word of God!

- Create your secret “War Room” for Spiritual Warfare, Intercessory Prayer; and fight the right way.
