

Miraculous Prosperity

Overview: Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father
Now all these things happened unto them for ensamples: and they are written for our admonition, upon whom the ends of the world are come. Joh 14:12

A. Miraculous Provision.

1. Moses.
 - a) Moses' prayers brought manna (Ex 16:15) and quail from heaven. Num 11:31
 - b) Moses purified the bitter water at Marah by throwing a tree into it. Ex 15:25
 - c) Moses brought water from a rock twice by striking it. Ex 17:6
 - d) Moses directed the Hebrew slaves and they plundered the wealth of Egypt. Ex 12:36
 - e) Shoes and clothes did not wear out in the wilderness. Ex 29:5
2. Elijah.
 - a) Elijah was fed by ravens during the famine. 1 Kin 17:4
 - b) Elijah declared that the oil and the meal would never run out until the famine ended. 1 Kin 17:14
 - c) Elijah outran Ahab on his horse. 1 Kin 18:46
3. Elisha.
 - a) Elisha declared the end of famine in the city and the lepers scared away the enemy. 2Ki 7:1-16
 - b) Elisha prayed & oil filled the widow's vessels; She sold the oil, paid her debt. 2Ki 4:7
and with her two sons lived off the remaining money.
4. Jesus.
 - a) Jesus turned water to wine. John 2:9
 - b) Jesus multiplied the loaves and fishes on two occasions. (Mark 6:41). Matt 15:36
 - c) Jesus got money from a fish to pay taxes. Matt 17:27
 - d) Jesus sent out disciples without money or extra clothes. Mt 10:9,10
5. Paul.
 - a) Paul was resupplied with supplies, enough to live on for 2 years (Acts 28:30). Acts 28:10
6. Modern church.
 - a) Buy without money.
 - (1) And he causeth all, both small and great, rich and poor, free and bond, to receive a mark in their right hand, or in their foreheads. Rev 13:16
 - (2) And that no man might buy or sell, save he that had the mark, or the name of the beast, or the number of his name. Rev 13:17
 - (3) Ho, every one that thirsteth, come ye to the waters, and he that hath no money; come ye, buy, and eat; yea, come, buy wine and milk without money and without price. Isa 55:1
 - 1) An orphanage during WW2 got a supply ship full of food.
 - 2) John G. Lake was given a new house on his first day in Africa.
 - 3) Nora Lam was fed in prison by rats bringing her food.
 - 4) Pastor Jan cooked a roast without gas in her oven.
 - 5) Pastor Joshua was once paid \$10,000 for spending a week reading some technical material in preparation for a meeting.
 - 6) Pastora Karen drove 200+ miles per day for over 10 days with gas tank below empty.
 - 7) A lady, who was financially challenged, decided to volunteer at Thanksgiving on a one-day ministry event feeding the poor and returned home with 3 months of food.

- 8) And when the tempter came to him, he said, If thou be the Son of God, Mat 4:3
command that these stones be made bread. Water into wine or stone into
bread. What is the difference to God or to God in you?
- b) The God of the Increase will multiply your possessions.
- (1) The LORD shall increase you more and more, you and your children. Psa 115:14
- (2) And I will multiply the fruit of the tree, & the increase of the field, that you may Eze 36:30
no more suffer the reproach and **disgrace of famine** among the heathen. AMPC
- (3) And God will love thee, and bless thee, and multiply thee. Deu 7:13
- 1) God parted the Red Sea when Moses stretched out his rod.(+10 more miracles)Ex 14:16
- 2) The iron axe floated upward when Elisha cast a stick in the water. 2 Kin 6:6
- 3) After fixing man's car, Carlos was given \$850,000 to meet a mortgage payment.
- 4) Pastor Joshua was put in charge of a Hollywood project to produce 5 movies.
- 5) A pastor prayed for a man's hotel; hot springs were found on the property,
which he sold for a multi-million-dollar profit in about 18 months.
- 6) ABCer had a new car, 2 years old, which had a repeated problem. She got fed up,
prayed and the dealer gave her a brand new car at no charge.
- 7) ABCer had an older vehicle stolen & within hours was given money to replace it.
- 8) Person came to ABC for prayer after losing two of his businesses due to a law suit;
and now they were going for his home. After prayer, there was a miraculous
outcome as he not only won the case and kept his home but all of the previous
decisions were reversed.
- 9) Person came to ABC after losing a 6 figure settlement in a law suit; after prayer,
the decision was overturned and instead of paying it, the person received a six
figure amount; used it to buy real estate and parleyed into 1 million in about 1 year.
- 10) A long time ago, during a financially trying time, Pastor Joshua was paid
\$10,000 for an internet web address (i.e., one ".com" name).

B. Miraculous Control.

1. Over Celestial Bodies.
 - a) Joshua stopped the sun and moon in order to win a battle. Jos 10:12
 - b) Isaiah made the sun go backwards as a sign to Hezekiah. Isa 38:8
2. Over water.
 - a) Jesus and Peter walked on water. Matt 14:29
 - b) Jesus stilled the storm. Mark 4:39
 - c) Moses (Ex 14:22), Joshua (Jos 3:17), Elijah (2 Ki 2:8), and Elisha parted sea & river. 2 Ki 2:14
3. Over Fire.
 - a) Numerous examples exist at ABC and in the body of Christ.
 - b) Pastor Joshua's home in Malibu was untouched even when the neighborhood was burned.
4. Over mountains.
 - a) Numerous examples over mountains of obstacles exist at ABC and in the body of Christ.
 - b) Physical mountains were moved by the one-eyed shoemaker, by a pastor in Mexico to get TBN reception and by Pastor Peter at his Prayer Mountain.
5. Over demons.
 - a) Apostle Paul used his handkerchiefs as prayer cloths and demons came out of many. Acts 19:12
 - b) ABC prayed over a man's favorite shirt; the power of hell was broken in his life; he broke up with his girlfriend, who was a witch; got saved and was restored to his wife.

C. Miraculous Behavior.

1. Over Time.

- a) Jesus got on the boat in the middle of the sea and it was immediately (55x in NT) at their intended location. John 6:21
- b) Multiple instances of time appearing frozen as ABCers accomplish impossible feats.

2. Over Distance.

- a) So the Spirit lifted me up, and took me away, and I went in bitterness, in the heat of my spirit; but the hand of the LORD was strong upon me. Eze 3:14
- b) The hand of the LORD was upon me, and carried me out in the spirit of the LORD, and set me down in the midst of the valley which *was* full of bones, Eze 37:1
- c) Philip came out of the water; was instantly translated to Azotus, about 25 miles away. Act 8:39
- d) John G. Lake was translated from South Africa to Wales, where he cast a demon out of a woman and got her released from a closed mental hospital.
- e) A pastor was translated to Africa and ministered to a young man who was being chased by natives; years later they were re-united when the young man, now also a pastor, was attending a Christian Convention in the USA where, to his delight, the pastor was one of the guest speakers.
- f) Pastor Joshua was translated in the spirit to eastern Europe to pray for a couple.

3. Over the Enemy.

- a) Elijah brought down fire to destroy the enemy. 2 King 1:10
- b) Elisha blinded the enemy. 2 King 6:17
- c) Jesus passed through attackers & we assume that they could not see and/or touch him. Luke 4:30
- d) Jesus hid himself in the temple (i.e., He made Himself invisible). John 8:59
- e) Pastor Joseph was invisible to the Chinese army.
- f) Brother Yuen was invisible escaping from the Chinese maximum security prison.
- g) Astrid passed down the river between the Thai and Burmese army and neither saw her.
- h) Sons of Zebedee wanted to call down fire on the Samarian town that rejected Jesus. Luk 9:54
And when his disciples James and John saw *this*, they said, Lord, wilt thou that we command fire to come down from heaven, and consume them, even as Elias did?
- i) And if any man will hurt them, fire proceedeth out of their mouth, and devoureth their enemies: and if any man will hurt them, he must in this manner be killed. Rev 11:5
