Living Daily in the Spirit

Overview:

Gal 5:25 If we live in the Spirit, let us also walk in the Spirit.

1 Pet 4:6 For this cause was the gospel preached also to them that are dead, that they might be judged according to men in the flesh, but **live according to God in the spirit**.

Heb 12:9 Furthermore we have had fathers of our flesh which corrected us, and we gave them reverence: shall we not much rather <u>be in subjection unto the Father of spirits, and **live**.</u>

A. Living Daily in this World.

1. All that is in the World.

1 John 2:15 Love not the world, neither the things that are in the world. If any man love the world, the love of the Father is not in him.

1 John 2:16 For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world.

John 8:23 *Jesus said to those who desired to kill him* ... ye are of this world; I am not of this world.

2. Serve God or Mammon.

Matt 6:24 No man can serve two masters: for either he will hate the one, and love the other; or else he will hold to the one, and despise the other. Ye cannot serve God and mammon.

Jam 4:4 Ye adulterers and adulteresses, know ye not that the friendship of the world is enmity with God? whosoever therefore will be a friend of the world is the enemy of God.

John 15:19 If ye were of the world, the world would love his own: but because <u>ye are not of the world</u>, but I have chosen you out of the world, therefore the world hateth you.

- B. Choose Your Kingdom.
 - 1. Kingdom of Mammon.

Mammon is the Kingdom of satan, tracing back to the Tower of Babel. Mammon is the kingdom of the 5 senses. It is man's attempt to save himself. It includes business, industry, science, medicine and politics. Mammon is carnal, physical and fleshy.

Mammon is powered by money, so the love of money is the root of all evil.

2. Kingdom of God (KOG).

The KOG is wherever God has authority.

The KOG is living in Christ Jesus.

The KOG is spiritual, loving and peaceful.

The KOG is living in the Spirit.

The KOG is powered by faith.



- C. Living and Not Dying.
 - 1. The Glorious Church.

Eph 5:25 Christ also loved the church, and gave himself for it; Eph 5:26 That he might sanctify and cleanse it with the washing of water by the word,

Eph 527 That he might <u>present it to himself</u> a glorious church, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that it should be holy and without blemish. Gen 1-3 **What Adam and his family would be, if they had not sinned.**

2. Living through Obedience.

Rom 12:1 I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service.

Rom 12:2 And <u>be not conformed to this world</u>: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God

Hebrews 10:5 Wherefore when he cometh into the world, he saith, Sacrifice and offering thou wouldest not, but <u>a body hast thou prepared me</u>:

1 Pet 2:5 Ye also, as lively stones, are built up a spiritual house, an holy priesthood, to offer <u>up spiritual sacrifices</u>, acceptable to God by Jesus Christ. Gal 3:27 For as many of you as have been baptized into Christ have put on Christ. **Note**: We live in Christ Jesus by living with Jesus as Lord, being washed by obedience to His Word and to the leading of the Holy Spirit.

- D. Living Daily in the Spirit.
 - 1. Walking Daily in the Spirit.

Rom 8:1 There is therefore now <u>no condemnation</u> to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.

Rom 8:2 For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus hath made me free from the law of sin and death.

Rom 8:6 For to be carnally minded is death; but to be spiritually minded is life and peace.

Rom 8:7 Because the carnal mind is enmity against God: for it is not subject to the law of God, neither indeed can be. (**Note**: The carnal is serving mammon.) Rom 8:8 So then they that are in the flesh cannot please God.

Heb 11:6 Without faith, it is impossible to please God. If you are focused on the world, you are serving mammon, so you are not walking in faith.

Rom 8:11 But if the Spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, he that raised up Christ from the dead shall also <u>quicken</u> your mortal bodies by his Spirit that dwelleth in you.

Rom 8:13 For if ye live after the flesh, ye shall die: but if ye through the Spirit do mortify the deeds of the body, ye shall live.

Rom 8:14 For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God.



2. Your Personal Covenant with God.

Your Body Is Not Your Friend.

People say, "You are your own worst enemy."

Matt 26:41 Watch and pray, that ye enter not into temptation: the spirit indeed is willing, but the flesh is weak.

Phil 2:12 work out your own salvation with fear and trembling.

1 Cor 9:27 But <u>I keep under my body</u>, and bring it into subjection: <u>lest</u> that by any means, when I have preached to others, <u>I myself should be a **castaway**</u>.

2 Pet 3:11 Seeing then that all these things shall be dissolved, what manner of persons ought ye to be in all holy conversation and godliness,

2 Pet 3:12 Looking for and hasting unto the coming of the day of God, wherein the heavens being on fire shall be dissolved, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat?

2 Pet 3:13 Nevertheless we, according to his promise, look for new heavens and a new earth, wherein dwelleth righteousness.

2 Pet 3:14 Wherefore, beloved, seeing that ye look for such things, be diligent that ye may be found of him in **peace, without spot, and blameless**.

How Do You Do It?

Matt 26:28 You have a Blood Covenant with Jesus. He provided the blood; you provide your body as a living sacrifice (Rom 12:1). Everything already belongs to you and will be manifested as you continue to live in obedience. 1 Sam 15:22 To obey is better than sacrifice.

You make a personal covenant with God for each day so you are living in obedience when you keep the items in your covenant.

Your Matrix is your personal covenant, created by the leading of the Spirit. Your Matrix is your roadmap to the Pearl of Great Price,

Rev 21:7 The Pearl of Great Price is your total redemption which is being an overcomer who inherits all things and lives with Jesus forever. <u>You achieve</u> <u>this when you are alive and remain true to the Gospel at the return of</u> **Messiah Jesus and are raptured.**

The Matrix keeps you living in the Spirit, walking in the Spirit, living in Intervals of Faith, living under grace and moving toward living without sinning.

The Matrix is your ramp into the <u>Ark of Anointing</u>, your daily steps toward becoming <u>a member of the Glorious Church</u>.

Use the Matrix to build your day around God and not around mammon.
