

## If God Said It, Just Do It!

**Overview:** God's promises are conditional – **if** you obey certain conditions, you will receive that promise. Around 1,500 verses in the Bible contain the word “**if**.” There are lots of other promises in Scripture that do not use the word “**if**” but contain promises given to everyone who meet that condition like John 3:16. **If** the Bible gives you a promise and you do it, it will be fulfilled. **If** God said it, just do it!

### A. If You Confess and Believe in Your Heart, You Will Be Saved. Rom 10:9-10

1. 9 that **if** you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved.
- 10 For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto.

### B. If You Diligently Obey God, Blessings Shall Overtake You. Deut 28:1-2

1. 1 Now it shall come to pass, **if** you diligently obey the voice of the Lord your God, to observe carefully all His commandments which I command you today, that the Lord your God will set you high above all nations of the earth. 2 And all these blessings shall come upon you and overtake you, because you obey the voice of the Lord your God.

### C. If You Abide in God’s Word, You Will Be a Disciple Set Free. John 8:31-32

31 Then Jesus said to those Jews who believed Him, “**If** you abide in My word, you are My disciples indeed. 32 And you shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free.”

1. Three Prayer Keys to successful spiritual warfare.
  - a. Persistent in prayer.
  - b. Consistent in prayer.
  - c. Frequent in prayer.

## D. If You Forgive, You Will be Forgiven.

Mark 11:25

### 1. Mark 11:22-26 (AMPC)

22 And Jesus, replying, said to them, Have faith in God [constantly].

23 Truly I tell you, whoever says to this mountain, Be lifted up and thrown into the sea! and does not doubt at all in his heart but believes that what he says will take place, it will be done for him.

24 For this reason I am telling you, whatever you ask for in prayer, believe (trust and be confident) that it is granted to you, and you will [get it].

25 And whenever you stand praying, **if** you have anything against anyone, forgive him and let it drop (leave it, let it go), in order that your Father Who is in heaven may also forgive you your [own] failings and shortcomings and let them drop.

26 But **if** you do not forgive, neither will your Father in heaven forgive your failings and shortcomings.
