Part 4 – WORKSHOP - 2

A. Take Your Authority and Dominion Using Your Anointing

- 1. Don't let Satan steal your anointing through sin.
- 2. Satan is trying to keep you beaten down; so don't let him.
 - a. Sampson had an anointing upon him.
 - b. He gave up his anointing because of sin with Delilah.
- 3. Rom 3:23 For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.
- 4. 1 John 1:9 (AMPC) If we [freely] admit that we have sinned and confess our sins, He is faithful and just (true to His own nature and promises) and will forgive our sins [dismiss our lawlessness] and [continuously] cleanse us from all unrighteousness [everything not in conformity to His will in purpose, thought, and action].
 - a. We pray this prayer often, do you really receive it?

WORKSHOP: <u>Where is the devil is NOT fleeing from you because you may not</u> be aware of what sin to repent of or curse to break because you didn't know what law was broken ?

Answer these questions by writing down your answers:

James 4:7 (AMPC) So be subject (submitted) to God. Resist the devil [stand firm against him], and he will flee from you.

- Do you still have any challenges?
- Where are you still not submitted to God so you cannot resist the devil; therefore, he is not fleeing from you in these areas?
- Where are you not submitting to God so you are unable to resist the devil so he is not fleeing from you in the following areas:

o Challenge of Impatience?

Psalm 37:7 (AMPC) Be still and rest in the Lord; wait for Him and patiently lean yourself upon Him; fret not yourself because of him who prospers in his way, because of the man who brings wicked devices to pass.

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• Challenges of having a sickness or diagnosis that hasn't been overcome yet?

Psalm 107:20 (AMPC) He sends forth His word and heals them and rescues them from the pit and destruction.

o Challenges of aches, pain, or suffering?

1 Peter 5:10 (AMPC) And after you have suffered a little while, the God of all grace [Who imparts all blessing and favor], Who has called you to His [own] eternal glory in Christ Jesus, will Himself complete and make you what you ought to be, establish and ground you securely, and strengthen, and settle you.

• Challenges with relationships?

John 13:34 (AMPC) give you a new commandment: that you should love one another. Just as I have loved you, so you too should love one another.

o Challenges with finances?

Eccl 5:19 (AMPC) Also, every man to whom God has given riches and possessions, and the power to enjoy them and to accept his appointed lot and to rejoice in his toil—this is the gift of God [to him].

• Challenges with anxiety, stress, or feeling overwhelmed?

Philippians 4:6 (AMPC) Do not fret or have any anxiety about anything, but in every circumstance and in everything, by prayer and petition (definite requests), with thanksgiving, continue to make your wants known to God.

o Challenges of feeling tired?

Isaiah 40:31 (AMPC) But those who wait for the Lord [who expect, look for, and hope in Him] shall change and renew their strength and power; they shall lift their wings and mount up [close to God] as eagles [mount up to the sun]; they shall run and not be weary, they shall walk and not faint or become tired.

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• Challenges of fear?

Psalm 34:4 (AMPC) I sought (inquired of) the Lord and required Him [of necessity and on the authority of His Word], and He heard me, and delivered me from all my fears.

o Challenges with unforgiveness or self-unforgiveness?

Matt 6:14-15 (AMPC) For if you forgive people their trespasses [their reckless and willful sins, leaving them, letting them go, and giving up resentment], your heavenly Father will also forgive you. 15 But if you do not forgive others their trespasses [their reckless and willful sins, leaving them, letting them go, and giving up resentment], neither will your Father forgive you your trespasses.

• Challenges of taking offense from someone else or being offensive to others?

Prov 19:11 (AMPC) Good sense makes a man restrain his anger, and it is his glory to overlook a transgression or an offense.

• Challenges of pride, arrogance and haughtiness?

Prov 16:18-20 (AMPC) 18 Pride goes before destruction, and a haughty spirit before a fall. 19 Better it is to be of a humble spirit with the meek and poor than to divide the spoil with the proud. 20 He who deals wisely and heeds [God's] word and counsel shall find good, and whoever leans on, trusts in, and is confident in the Lord—happy, blessed, and fortunate is he.

Prov 11:12 (AMPC) He who belittles and despises his neighbor lacks sense, but a man of understanding keeps silent.

• Challenges of strife, confusion, scoffing, and every evil work connected to them?

James 3:16 (AMPC) For wherever there is jealousy (envy) and contention (rivalry and selfish ambition), there will also be confusion (unrest, disharmony, rebellion) and all sorts of evil and vile practices.
