

What You Say Will Be Done - WORKSHOP

A. What You Say Will Be Done So Control Your Tongue.

1. You will have what you say.

Mk 11:23 (AMPC)

a) Whoever says to this mountain, be lifted up and thrown into the sea...and does not doubt at all in his heart but believes that **what he says will** take place, it will **be done** for him.

2. Do not speak bad words of:

a) doubt

Mk 11:23; Jas 1:6

James 1:6-8 (AMPC)

- 6 But he must ask [for wisdom] in faith, without doubting [God's willingness to help], for the one who doubts is like a billowing surge of the sea that is blown about and tossed by the wind.
- 7 For such a person ought not to think or expect that he will receive anything [at all] from the Lord,
- 8 being a double-minded man, unstable and restless in all his ways [in everything he thinks, feels, or decides].

Do not speak bad words of:

b) unbelief

Heb 3:12; Rom 4:20-22

- Heb 3:12 (AMPC) [Therefore beware] brethren, take care, lest there be in any one of you a wicked, unbelieving heart [which refuses to cleave to, trust in, and rely on Him], leading you to turn away and desert or stand aloof from the living God.
- Rom 4:20-22 (AMPC) 20 No unbelief or distrust made him waver (doubtingly question) concerning the promise of God, but he grew strong and was empowered by faith as he gave praise and glory to God.
- 21 Fully satisfied and assured that God was able and mighty to keep His word and to do what He had promised.
- 22 That is why his faith was credited to him as righteousness (right standing with God).



Do not speak bad words of:

c) fear 2 Tim 1:7; Ps 56:3-4

- 2 Tim 1:7 (AMPC) For God did not give us a spirit of timidity (of cowardice, of craven and cringing and fawning fear), but [He has given us a spirit] of power and of love and of calm and well-balanced mind and discipline and self-control.
- Ps 56:3-4 (AMPC) 3 What time I am afraid, I will have confidence in and put my trust and reliance in You.
- 4 By [the help of] God I will praise His word; on God I lean, rely, and confidently put my trust; I will not fear. What can man, who is flesh, do to me?

Do not speak bad words of:

d) negativity

Eph 4:29; Eph 5:4

- Eph 4:29 (AMPC) Let no foul or polluting language, nor evil word nor unwholesome or worthless talk [ever] come out of your mouth, but only such [speech] as is good and beneficial to the spiritual progress of others, as is fitting to the need and the occasion, that it may be a blessing and give grace (God's favor) to those who hear it.
- Eph 5:4 (AMPC) Let there be no filthiness (obscenity, indecency) nor foolish and sinful (silly and corrupt) talk, nor coarse jesting, which are not fitting or becoming; but instead voice your thankfulness [to God].
- 3. No man can tame his own tongue, so God needs to tame the tongue.

Jas 3:8

James 3:2-8 (AMPC)

2 For we all often stumble and fall and offend in many things. And if anyone does not offend in speech [never says the wrong things], he is a fully developed character and a perfect man, able to control his whole body and to curb his entire nature. 3 If we set bits in the horses' mouths to make them obey us, we can turn their whole bodies about. 4 Likewise, look at the ships: though they are so great and are driven by rough winds, they are steered by a very small rudder wherever the impulse of the helmsman determines.



- 5 Even so the tongue is a little member, and it can boast of great things. See how much wood or how great a forest a tiny spark can set a blaze!
- 6 And the tongue is a fire. [The tongue is a] world of wickedness set among our members, contaminating and depraving the whole body and setting on fire the wheel of birth (the cycle of man's nature), being itself ignited by hell (Gehenna). 7 For every kind of beast and bird, of reptile and sea animal, can be tamed and has been tamed by human genius (nature).
- 8 But the human tongue can be tamed by no man. It is a restless (undisciplined, irreconcilable) evil, full of deadly poison.
- Control your tongue by speaking affirmations or by praying a lot in tongues.
- a) **Affirm Ps 19:14:** In the name of Jesus, God has made the words of my mouth and the meditations of my heart pleasing to Him.

B. What You Say Will Be Done and Can Make You More Successful.

1. Your tongue is the key to your success.

Prov 18:21

- Your tongue is the key to your success.
- Prov 18:21 states that death and life are in the power of your tongue.
- Deut 30:19 says that you have the power to choose life or death, blessings or curses.
- You choose them with your words.
- 2. Speak godly words:
 - a) filled with faith from your heart.

 Mark 11:22-24 (AMPC)

Mk 11:22-24

22 Jesus replied, "Have faith in God [constantly]. 23 I assure you and most solemnly say to you, whoever says to this mountain, 'Be lifted up and thrown into the sea!' and does not doubt in his heart [in God's unlimited power], but believes that what he says is going to take place, it will be done for him [in accordance with God's will]. 24 For this reason I am telling you, whatever things you ask for in prayer [in accordance with God's will], believe [with confident trust] that you have received them, and they will be given to you.



Practice:

- Don't agree with people who tell you that every Winter, they catch the flu, so'll they say they'll probably get covid too.
- Declare that your head has been healed by the stripes of Jesus, then
 afterwards when tempted to take an aspirin for what has been a
 regularly recurring minor headache, resist the devil so he will flee
 from you by doing your affirmations of the Gos-pel instead of taking
 a pain-ill.

Speak godly words:

b) that are positive, uplifting, and edifying. Heb 10:23; Col 3:16 Heb 10:23 (AMPC) So let us seize and hold fast and retain without wavering the hope we cherish and confess and our acknowledgement of it, for He Who promised is reliable (sure) and faithful to His word.

Col 3:16 (AMPC) 16 Let the word [spoken by] Christ (the Messiah) have its home [in your hearts and minds] and dwell in you in [all its] richness, as you teach and admonish and train one another in all insight and intelligence and wisdom [in spiritual things, and as you sing] psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, making melody to God with [His] grace in your hearts.

Speak godly words:

c) that encourage others .

2 Tim 4:2

2 Tim 4:2 (AMPC) 2 Herald and preach the Word! Keep your sense of urgency [stand by, be at hand and ready], whether the opportunity seems to be favorable or unfavorable. [Whether it is convenient or inconvenient, whether it is welcome or unwelcome, you as preacher of the Word are to show people in what way their lives are wrong.] And convince them, rebuking and correcting, warning and urging and encouraging them, being unflagging and inexhaustible in patience and teaching.

Speak godly words:

d) that are gracious to the hearers.

Eph 4:29

Eph 4:29 29 Let no foul or polluting language, nor evil word nor unwholesome or worthless talk [ever] come out of your mouth, but only such [speech] as is good and beneficial to the spiritual progress of others, as is fitting to the need and the occasion, that it may be a blessing and give grace (God's favor) to those who hear it.

C. What You Say Will Be Done and Can Change Your Life.

- 1. God's Word gives you a hopeful future. Jer 29:11

 Jer 29:11 (AMPC) For I know the thoughts and plans that I have for you,
 says the Lord, thoughts and plans for welfare and peace and not for
 evil, to give you hope in your final outcome.
- God's Word changes the unseen.
 Cor 4:18 (AMPC) Since we consider and look not to the things that are seen but to the things that are unseen; for the things that are visible are temporal (brief and fleeting), but the things that are invisible are deathless and everlasting.
- God's Word made you a new creation.
 Cor 5:17 (AMPC) Therefore if any person is [ingrafted] in Christ (the Messiah) he is a new creation (a new creature altogether); the old [previous moral and spiritual condition] has passed away. Behold, the fresh and new has come!
- 4. God's Word transforms you by the renewing Rom 12:2; Eph 4:22-24 of your mind to righteousness and holiness.
 - Rom 12:2 (AMPC) 2 Do not be conformed to this world (this age), [fashioned after and adapted to its external, superficial customs], but be transformed (changed) by the [entire] renewal of your mind [by its new ideals and its new attitude], so that you may prove [for yourselves] what is the good and acceptable and perfect will of God, even the thing which is good and acceptable and perfect [in His sight for you].
 - Eph 4:22-24 (AMPC) 22 Strip yourselves of your former nature [put off and discard your old unrenewed self] which characterized your previous manner of life and becomes corrupt through lusts and desires that spring from delusion;
 - 23 And be constantly renewed in the spirit of your mind [having a fresh mental and spiritual attitude],
 - 24 And put on the new nature (the regenerate self) created in God's image, Godlike] in true **righteousness and holiness**.



- God's Word gives you everlasting life.
 1 Cor 15:51
 1 Cor 15:51 (AMPC) Take notice! I tell you a mystery (a secret truth, an event decreed by the hidden purpose or counsel of God). We shall not all fall asleep [in death], but we shall all be changed (transformed)
- 6. God's Word causes you to overcome, inherit Rev 21:7 all things and He will be your God and you will be His Son or Daughter.
- 7. Heaven and earth will pass away, but My [God's] Mt 24:35 Words will by no means pass away.

Practice walking in faith by praying for everything that you need or desire for which the means of achieving them are beyond your current resources by believing that the Word of God of What You Say will be Done, in the Name of Jesus.
