### A. What You Say Will Be Done So Control Your Tongue.

### B. What You Say Will Be Done and Can Make You More Successful.

1. Your tongue is the key to your success. Prov 18:21
  - a. Your tongue is the key to your success.
  - b. Prov 18:21 states that death and life are in the power of your tongue.
  - c. Deut 30:19 says that you have the power to choose life or death, blessings or curses.
  - d. You choose them with your words.
  
2. Speak godly words:
  - a. Speak godly words: filled with faith from your heart. Mk 11:22-24
    - Mark 11:22-24  
22 Jesus replied, “Have **faith in God [constantly]**. 23 I assure you and most solemnly say to you, whoever says to this mountain, ‘Be lifted up and thrown into the sea!’ and does not doubt in his heart [in God’s unlimited power], but believes that **what he says** is going to take place, it **will be done** for him [in accordance with God’s will]. 24 For this reason I am telling you, whatever things you ask for in prayer [in accordance with God’s will], believe [with confident trust] that you have received them, and they will be given to you.
  - b. **Practice:**
    - Don’t agree with people who tell you that every Winter, they catch the flu, so’ll they say they’ll probably get covid too.
    - Declare that your head has been healed by the stripes of Jesus, then afterwards when tempted to take an aspirin for what has been a regularly recurring minor headache, resist the devil so he will flee from you by doing your affirmations of the Gos-pel instead of taking a pain-pill.
  - c. Speak godly words: that are positive, uplifting, Heb 10:23; Col 3:16 and edifying.
    - Heb 10:23 (AMPC) So let us seize and hold fast and retain without wavering the hope we cherish and confess and our acknowledgement of it, for He Who promised is reliable (sure) and faithful to His word.

- Col 3:16 (AMPC) 16 Let the word [spoken by] Christ (the Messiah) have its home [in your hearts and minds] and dwell in you in [all its] richness, as you teach and admonish and train one another in all insight and intelligence and wisdom [in spiritual things, and as you sing] psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, making melody to God with [His] grace in your hearts.
- d. Speak godly words: that encourage others 2 Tim 4:2
  - 2 Tim 4:2 (AMPC) 2 Herald and preach the Word! Keep your sense of urgency [stand by, be at hand and ready], whether the opportunity seems to be favorable or unfavorable. [Whether it is convenient or inconvenient, whether it is welcome or unwelcome, you as preacher of the Word are to show people in what way their lives are wrong.] And convince them, rebuking and correcting, warning and urging and encouraging them, being unflagging and inexhaustible in patience and teaching.
- e. Speak godly words: that are gracious to the hearers. Eph 4:29
  - Eph 4:29 29 Let no foul or polluting language, nor evil word nor unwholesome or worthless talk [ever] come out of your mouth, but only such [speech] as is good and beneficial to the spiritual progress of others, as is fitting to the need and the occasion, that it may be a blessing and give grace (God's favor) to those who hear it.

### **C. What You Say Will Be Done and Can Change Your Life.**

1. God's Word gives you a hopeful future. Jer 29:11
  - a. Jer 29:11 (AMPC) For I know the thoughts and plans that I have for you, says the Lord, thoughts and plans for welfare and peace and not for evil, to give you hope in your final outcome.
2. God's Word changes the unseen. 2 Cor 4:18
  - a. 2 Cor 4:18 (AMPC) Since we consider and look not to the things that are seen but to the things that are unseen; for the things that are visible are temporal (brief and fleeting), but the things that are invisible are deathless and everlasting.
3. God's Word made you a new creation. 2 Cor 5:17

- a. 2 Cor 5:17 (AMPC) Therefore if any person is [ingrafted] in Christ (the Messiah) he is a new creation (a new creature altogether); the old [previous moral and spiritual condition] has passed away. Behold, the fresh and new has come!
  
4. God's Word transforms you by the renewing of your mind to righteousness and holiness. Rom 12:2; Eph 4:22-24
  - a. Rom 12:2 (AMPC) 2 **Do not be conformed to this world (this age), [fashioned after and adapted to its external, superficial customs], but be transformed (changed) by the [entire] renewal of your mind [by its new ideals and its new attitude]**, so that you may prove [for yourselves] what is the good and acceptable and perfect will of God, even the thing which is good and acceptable and perfect [in His sight for you].
  - b. Eph 4:22-24 (AMPC) 22 Strip yourselves of your former nature [put off and discard your old renewed self] which characterized your previous manner of life and becomes corrupt through lusts and desires that spring from delusion; **23 And be constantly renewed in the spirit of your mind [having a fresh mental and spiritual attitude]**, 24 And put on the new nature (the regenerate self) created in God's image, Godlike] in true **righteousness and holiness.**
  
5. God's Word gives you everlasting life. 1 Cor 15:51
  - a. 1 Cor 15:51 (AMPC) Take notice! I tell you a mystery (a secret truth, an event decreed by the hidden purpose or counsel of God). We shall not all fall asleep [in death], but we shall all be changed (transformed).
  
6. God's Word causes you to overcome, inherit all things and He will be your God and you will be His Son or Daughter. Rev 21:7
  
7. Heaven and earth will pass away, but My [God's] Words will by no means pass away. Mt 24:35

**Recommendation:** Practice walking in faith by praying for everything that you need or desire for which the means of achieving them are beyond your current resources. Believe that **What You Say will be Done**, just as the Word of God decrees, in the Name of Jesus.
