

Sealed by the Holy Spirit

Overview.

You build your Ark of Anointing for you and your loved ones by partnering with the Holy Spirit. He will never leave you nor forsake you. He is here with you to lead you, teach you, guide you, comfort you and protect you as He gets you ready for the Rapture. As the Ending Days get worse and the anointing in you gets better, the anointing in you will draw your family and friends closer to you and to the Lord. The major tool for building this anointing is our ABC Covenant Matrix with God.

A. Your Redemption.

1. John 3:3 Jesus answered and said unto him, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God.
John 3:5 Jesus answered, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God.
2. Eph 4:29 Let no corrupt communication proceed out of your mouth, but that which is good to the use of edifying, that it may minister grace unto the hearers. v30 And grieve not the holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption.
3. 2 Cor 5:17 Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.
Eph 5:27 That he might present it to himself a glorious church, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that it should be holy and without blemish.
4. 1 Cor 15:51 Behold, I shew you a mystery; We shall not all sleep (*die*), but we shall all be changed, v52 In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed.
1 Thes 4:17 Then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord.

B. Partnering with the Holy Spirit.

1. Commitment and Consecration.
Luke 9:22 The Son of man must suffer many things, and be rejected of the elders and chief priests and scribes, and be slain, and be raised the third day.
v23 And he said to them all, If any man will come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily, and follow me.
v24 For whosoever will save his life shall lose it: but whosoever will lose his life for my sake, the same shall save it.
v25 For what is a man advantaged, if he gain the whole world, and lose himself, or be cast away?

In Matt 16:21-27, Mark 8:31-37, John 12:7, 24-25, 33, Jesus also speaks about His own dying, **immediately** before referring to the need for “whosoever will lose his life”. (In Matt 10 and Luke 17, Jesus speaks about “whosoever will lose his life” in the context of the Ending Days.)

2. Protection and Purpose.

Luke 9:1 Then he called his twelve disciples together, and gave them power and authority over all devils, and to cure diseases.

Luke 9:2 And he sent them to preach the kingdom of God, and to heal the sick.

Luke 10:17 And the seventy returned again with joy, saying, Lord, even the devils are subject unto us through thy name.

v18 And he said unto them, I beheld Satan as lightning fall from heaven.

v19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.

v20 Notwithstanding in this rejoice not, that the spirits are subject unto you; but rather rejoice, because your names are written in heaven.

3. Living in His Presence.

Ps 91:1 He that dwelleth in the secret place of the most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty.

v2 I will say of the Lord, He is my refuge and my fortress: my God; in him will I trust.

v3 Surely he shall deliver thee from the snare of the fowler, and from the noisome pestilence.

v9 Because thou hast made the Lord, which is my refuge, even the most High, thy habitation;

v10 There shall no evil befall thee, neither shall any plague come nigh thy dwelling.

4. Living in the Seal.

John 16:7 Nevertheless I tell you the truth; It is **expedient** for you that I go away: for if I go not away, the Comforter will not come unto you; but if I depart, I will send him unto you.

John 14:16 And I will pray the Father, and he shall give you another Comforter, that he may abide with you for ever; v26 he shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you.

Col 1:9 In the Name of Jesus, I pray that the Holy Spirit will continue to fill me with the knowledge of Father’s will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding;

Heb 13:5 Let your conversation be without covetousness; and be content with such things as ye have: for he hath said, I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee. v6 So that we may boldly say, The Lord is my helper, and I will not fear

what man shall do unto me.

C. The Holy Spirit in the Ending Days.

1. The Seal of Protection.

The 144,000 under Grace.

Rev 7:2 And I saw another angel ascending from the east, having the seal of the living God: and he cried with a loud voice to the four angels, to whom it was given to hurt the earth and the sea,

v3 Saying, Hurt not the earth, neither the sea, nor the trees, till we have sealed the servants of our God in their foreheads.

Noah under Grace.

Mt 24:37 But as the days of Noah were, so shall also the coming of the Son of man be. V 38 For as in the days that were before the flood they were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, until the day that Noe entered into the ark.

Gen 6:7 And the Lord said, I will destroy man whom I have created from the face of the earth; both man, and beast, and the creeping thing, and the fowls of the air; for it repenteth me that I have made them.

Gen 6:8 But Noah found grace in the eyes of the Lord.

Gen 6:13 And God said unto Noah, The end of all flesh is come before me; for the earth is filled with violence through them; and, behold, I will destroy them with the earth.

2. Hear and Overcome.

Rom 8:14 For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God.

Rev 21:7 He that overcomes shall inherit all things; and I will be his God, and he shall be my son.

In the BOR, there are eight verses which refer to the Spirit speaking.

Three references discuss an overcomer in the same verse (Rev 2:7,11,17).

Example:

Rev 2:11 He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; He that overcomes shall not be hurt of the second death.

Three references are immediately preceded by a verse talking about overcoming (Rev 3:6,13, 22).

Example:

Rev 3:5 He that overcomes, the same shall be clothed in white raiment; and I will not blot out his name out of the book of life, but I will confess his name before my Father, and before his angels.

Rev 3:6 He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches.

In the 7th letter, the one to Thyatira, the admonition to “hear what the Spirit saith” is 3 verses after the statement on overcoming.

Conclusion: The expression, “Hear what the Spirit saith” is not referring to the prophetic revelations described in the BOR. It is an admonition to the end-time believers. It is repeated seven times, telling you and me that it is imperative to listen to the voice of the Holy Spirit to be an overcomer. Doesn't that remind you of Rom 8:14 For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God.

3. The Spirit invites you.

John 3:16 For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not **perish**, but have everlasting life.

Rev 22:17 And the Spirit and the bride say, Come. And let him that heareth say, Come. And let him that is athirst come. And whosoever will, let him take the water of life freely.

BOR ch 2-3 In the seven letters to the church, the Holy Spirit is inviting us to listen to His guidance to be alive and remain, be raptured, become an overcomer and have the right to enter New Jerusalem.

4. New Jerusalem.

The Bride of Christ.

Rev 21: 2 And I John saw the holy city, new Jerusalem, coming down from God out of heaven, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband.

v9 And there came unto me one of the seven angels which had the seven vials full of the seven last plagues, and talked with me, saying, Come hither, I will shew thee the bride, the Lamb's wife.

v10 And he carried me away in the spirit to a great and high mountain, and shewed me that great city, the holy Jerusalem, descending out of heaven from God.

The Righteousness of the Saints.

Rev 19:7 Let us be glad and rejoice, and give honour to him: for the marriage of the Lamb is come, and his wife hath made herself ready.

v8 And to her was granted that she should be arrayed in fine linen, clean and white: for the fine linen is the righteousness of saints.

Rev 22:14 Blessed are they that do his commandments, that they may have right to the tree of life, and may enter in through the gates into the city.
