

Release and Increase - Part 3

A. Don't Quit But Press On.

- 1. Press On Toward the Goal to Win the Prize.
 - a. Phil 3:14 (AMPC) I press on toward the goal to win the [supreme and heavenly] prize to which God in Christ Jesus is calling us upward.

B. Release the Past to Move Forward.

1. Phil 3:13-14 (ESV) ¹³ One thing I do: forgetting what lies behind and straining forward to what lies ahead, ¹⁴ I press on toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus.

C. A Prophetic Word For You from God for 2025 : "Release and Increase!"

- 1. After you "Release," God will "Increase" all His blessings to you.
 - a. 2 Cor 9:8 says, God is able to make all grace abound toward you, that you, always having all sufficiency in all things, may have an abundance for every good work.
- 2. Job 8:7 says, Though your beginning was small, yet your latter end would increase abundantly.

D. Press On to Towards Your Morning Miracles.

- 1. "The Morning Miracle" book was written because the Holy Spirit initiated it. This book shows how much we care about you; and we invite Christians worldwide to join us on this journey to transform lives around the world.
- 2. The title of this book has a two-fold objective:
 - a. First, to seek first the Kingdom of God as it says in Matthew 6:33 for a spiritual awakening to God.
 - b. Second, 6:33 a.m. is the specific time the Holy Spirit is encouraging you to awaken to pray by yourself, in the privacy of your own location and time zone or join us live on Zoom (Pacific Time).
- 3. Are you ready for the more challenging times ahead as it says in Revelation?
- 4. Do you experience miracles frequently as part of your normal life?
- 5. Can you help other people get their miracle(s)?
- 6. Are you doing the necessary spiritual steps to obtain your miracle(s)?
 - a. Matt 6:33 But seek first the Kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you.
- 7. Would you like more of "all these things" of greater blessings "added to you?"



- 8. Do you realize that after you study all 12 chapters that you will be experiencing much more exciting prayer results when you do what is recommended daily?
- 9. The 633ers who have been seeing results through the Prayer of Agreement combined with Intercession and the Prayer of Unity have greater victories because we have taught them these successful strategies, insightful secrets and powerful keys which have been developed from a combination of our experiences the Holy Spirit taught us and from anointed teachings from our church.

E. A.B.C. at 6:33!

- 1. Ps 63:1 says, "Early will I seek You...My soul thirsts for You.
- 2. Ps 5:3, My voice You shall hear in the morning, O Lord; In the morning I will direct it to You.
- 3. Heb 10:25 says, Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together...but exhorting one another...more as you see the Day approaching.
 - a. The Holy Spirit gave us a Word to gather and assemble the Body of Christ (A.B.C.) to pray together early in the morning at 6:33 a.m.
 - b. It is of utmost importance, especially because things in our country and on the earth are going through turbulent times with more to come.

F. The Triple Triumphant Prayer Method is More Powerful.

- 1. Intercession is one of the many powerful prayer methods.
 - a. Rom 8:26 says, Likewise the Spirit also helps in our weaknesses. For we do not know what we should pray for as we ought, but the Spirit Himself makes intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered.
- 2. The Prayer of Agreement is one of many powerful prayer methods.
 - a. Matt 18:19-20 ¹⁹ Again I say to you that if two of you agree on earth concerning anything that they ask, it will be done for them by My Father in heaven. ²⁰ For where two or three are gathered together in My name, I am there in the midst of them.
- 3. The Prayer of Unity is one of the many powerful prayer methods.
 - a. Gen 11:6 says, And the Lord said, Indeed the people are one and they all have one language, and this is what they begin to do; now nothing that they propose to do will be withheld from them.
 - b. Acts 1:14 says, These all continued with one accord in prayer and supplication, with the women and Mary the mother of Jesus, and with His brothers.
 - c. Rom 15:6 says, That you may with one mind and one mouth glorify the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ.



G. Use the Triple Triumphant Prayer Method to Pray, Affirm, and Intercede.

- 1. Titus 3:8 says, Affirm constantly...these things are good and profitable.
- 2. Let's agree together when we say our affirmations, prayers, and personal private prayer to have more powerful, effective prayer results, victories, morning miracles and increase in every area of our lives!

H. How to Deal With Devastation Challenges.

- 1. Cherish precious memories.
 - a. Prov 10:7 The memory of the righteous is blessed.
- 2. God will give you new good memories when rebuilding your future.
 - a. Jer 29:11 For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, says the Lord, thoughts of peace and not of evil, to give you a future and a hope.
- 3. What the devil meant for evil, God will turn around Gen 50:20-22 for something good.

I. Expand Your Vision in 2025.

- 1. Habakkuk 2:2-3 Write the vision and make it plain on tablets, that he may run who reads it.
- 2. Prov 29:18 Where there is no revelation, the people cast off restraint; but happy is he who keeps the law.
- 3. Ask the Holy Spirit what the Heavenly Father wants you to do for 2025.
 - a. Then write your expanded vision down with the foundational scripture that confirms it.
 - b. Then set your vision before your eyes daily to remind yourself that you Should run with it.
 - c. Make either a Vision Board or a Vision Exhibit in your home of items that will encourage you to fulfill your 2025 vision!
 - d. Visualization will cause magnetization!
- 4. Develop your spiritual vision, perspective and strength like an eagle.
 - a. Is 40:31 AMPC But those who wait for the Lord [who expect, look for, and hope in Him] shall change and renew their strength and power; they shall lift their wings and mount up [close to God] as eagles [mount up to the sun]; they shall run and not be weary, they shall walk and not faint or become tired.
 - b. Renewed in strength like the eagle who is strong, overcomes, and soars. (Ps103:4-5 AMPC).



J. Increase in Spiritual Wisdom

1. Seek spiritual wisdom like Solomon did.

1 Kings 3; 4:29-34

2. ³ Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Eph 1:3-23 Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places in Christ, ⁴ just as He chose us in Him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before Him in love, ⁵ having predestined us to adoption

as sons by Jesus Christ to Himself, according to the good pleasure of His will, ⁶ to the praise of the glory of His grace, by which He made us accepted in the Beloved. ⁷ In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of His grace 8 which He made to abound toward us in all wisdom and prudence, 9 having made known to us the mystery of His will, according to His good pleasure which He purposed in Himself, ¹⁰ that in the dispensation of the fullness of the times He might gather together in one all things in Christ, [both which are in heaven and which are on earth—in Him. 11 In Him also we have obtained an inheritance, being predestined according to the purpose of Him who works all things according to the counsel of His will, 12 that we who first trusted in Christ should be to the praise of His glory. 13 In Him you also trusted, after you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation; in whom also, having believed, you were sealed with the Holy Spirit of promise, ¹⁴ who is the guarantee of our inheritance until the redemption of the purchased possession, to the praise of His glory. 15 Therefore I also, after I heard of your faith in the Lord Jesus and your love for all the saints, 16 do not cease to give thanks for you, making mention of you in my prayers: 17 that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give to you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of Him, ¹⁸ the eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that you may know what is the hope of His calling, what are the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints, ¹⁹ and what is the exceeding greatness of His power toward us who believe, according to the working of His mighty power 20 which He worked in Christ when He raised Him from the dead and seated Him at His right hand in the heavenly places, ²¹ far above all principality and power and might and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this age but also in that which is to come. ²² And He put all things under His feet, and gave Him to be head over all things to the church, 23 which is His body, the fullness of Him who fills all in all.
