

Prophetic Encouragement Series - Part 3: Affirm Encouraging Prophetic Messages

A. Affirm Encouraging Prophetic Messages that God Gave Pastor James:

- 1. Affirm: Thank You, God, our "I AM," for giving us the wisdom of Solomon. We believe in Your Word. We are courageous and not afraid. We will not let fear stop our anointing. We are as strong as the Word of God that resides IN us. The enemy's strongholds have come crashing down just like Jericho. The enemy is afraid of us. Because we are submitted to God, as it says, in James 4:7, we are empowered. "I AM" makes the impossible possible for all of us. We believe that what is naturally impossible for us, has already been made possible by God. NOW is the time for the Transfer of Wealth to come to us, in the Name of Jesus!
- 2. Affirm: In Jesus' Name, we see ourselves as God sees us. As we think in our hearts, so are we, according to Prov 23:7. We are mighty warriors of valor with great courage in the face of danger, especially in spiritual battles. We have gallant bravery, strength and valor. We want to be used by God to do spiritually mighty feats for Him. We embrace our challenges; and run towards the victory that God, the "I AM" has given us!
- 3. Affirm: In the Name of Jesus, we walk in our authority and power for our God, "I AM," has given us the GO as we take dominion. We fear not, for our God, "I AM," has given us a dream that is NOT too large. "I AM" is with us and our victorious example will lead many people to Him.
- 4. Affirm: Thank You, Lord, in the Name of Jesus for giving us a Season of Preparation. We will continue to move to a higher level of understanding which gives us a stronger anointing. We have been prepared for such a time as this and we are ready. We still must do our part, remembering that "I AM" is with us just as when David fought Goliath because we have faith in God!
- 5. Affirm: Thank You, Lord, in the Name of Jesus, that You, God, "I AM" gives us all the prosperity the devil took from us, just like when Jacob was given the prosperity taken by Laban. We will continue seeking God with ardent zeal and intense effort, as it says in Rom 12:11 with spiritual fervor. We will continue serving You, Lord.
- 6. Affirm: In the Name of Jesus, God has prepared us for such a time as this for "I AM" has seen our diligence.
- 7. Affirm: In the Name of Jesus, unlike lazy hands of poverty, our diligent hands bring us wealth, according to Prov 10:4.



- 8. Affirm: In the Name of Jesus, we will not be hasty like those in poverty; and our plans as the diligent will surely lead to abundance. Therefore, I will run with those godly plans! (Prov 21:5 ESV)
- 9. Affirm: Thank You, Jesus, for blessing us with a special impartation to receive all that our God, "I AM" has for us, including the Transfer of Wealth. God says we are ready and we have everything we need to start. "I AM" will give us more as we grow.
- 10. Affirm: "I AM" says we are worthy. So cast off any lies of the enemy telling us that we do not deserve to receive His blessings. It is time for the fruit of the harvest of all the seeds of prayers and love offerings we have sown in faith to come into fruition! (As of March 20, 2025, God made that a demarcation time in the Spirit realm of a New Season for the Body of Christ.)
- 11. Affirm: In the Name of Jesus, according to Psalm 56:8-10 (TPT), thank You, God, that You have stored our many tears in Your bottle—not one will be lost. For they are all recorded in Your book of remembrance. The very moment we call to You, Heavenly Father, for help, the tide of battle turns and our enemies flee. You, God are on our side. We trust in You, Lord and we praise You. We trust in the Word of God.
- 12. Affirm: In the Name of Jesus, God says to go forward with joy without tears because Jesus, Himself, has reached into the cockles of our hearts and pulled out all pain and regrets. (Cockles: the cores of one's being, deepest feelings).

B. Examples of the Results of Prophetic Messages of Encouragement from God:

- 1. 2 Chron 20:15-16 A prophetic Word from God told them where to go and God said, "Do not be afraid or discouraged because of this vast army. For the battle is not yours, but God's."
- 2 Chron 20:17 "You will not need to fight in this battle. Position yourselves, stand <u>still</u> and see the salvation of the Lord, who is with you, O Judah and Jerusalem!' **Do not fear or be dismayed**; tomorrow go out against them, for the Lord is with you."
 - a. "Still" in Hebrew means (that King Jehoshaphat and his Army needed to) stop and rest in the Lord and not plan on doing any fighting.
- 3. 2 Chron 20:21 (NKJV & NIV) Jehoshaphat put Praisers in front of his army to sing praises to God singing, "Give thanks to the Lord, for his love and mercy endures forever."



- 4. 2 Chron 20:22-26 As they began to sing and praise, the Lord set ambushes against the men of Ammon and Moab and Mount Seir who were invading Judah, and they were defeated (self-slaughtered AMPC); and they carried off their plunder. There was so much plunder that it took three days to collect it where they praised the Lord!
- 5. When the Hebrews praised the Lord, it sent confusion into the enemy camp. The enemy were so confused that they killed each other. Everyone of them died. God defeated them with confusion, just like He defeated others with confusion.
 - a. Exodus 14:24-25 (New Living Translation), says, "But early in the morning, the LORD looked down on the Egyptian army from the pillar of fire and cloud, and He threw them into confusion. Their chariot wheels began to come off, making their chariots impossible to drive. 'Let's get out of here!' the Egyptians shouted. 'The LORD is fighting for Israel against us!'"
 - b. Gen 11:4 says, "Come, let Us go down and there confuse their language, that they may not understand one another's speech" (vs 7).
 - c. Deut 7:23-24(NLT) says, Moses spoke about the victory the LORD would grant the Israelites over their enemies if they obeyed Him. He said, "But the LORD Your God will hand them over to you. He will throw them into complete confusion until they are destroyed. He (God) will put their kings in your power, and you will erase their names from the face of the earth. No one will be able to stand against you, and you will destroy them all".
 - d. Do not let confusion into your life by staying free of envy, self-seeking, strife, and every evil thing. (James 3:16-17)
- 6. 2 Chron 20:27-28 King Jehoshaphat and the men of Judah and Jerusalem returned joyfully, for the Lord supernaturally defeated the 3 enemy armies.
- 7. 2 Chron 20:29-30 29 The fear of God came on all the surrounding kingdoms when they heard how the Lord had fought against the enemies of Israel. 30 And the kingdom of Jehoshaphat was at peace, for his God had given him rest on every side.
- Acts 16:25-26 (AMPC) 25 But about midnight, as Paul and Silas were praying and singing hymns of praise to God, and the [other] prisoners were listening to them, 26 Suddenly there was a great earthquake, so that the very foundations of the prison were shaken; and at once all the doors were opened and everyone's shackles were unfastened.

C. Perfect Your Praise to Still (Stop) the Avenger to Get Your Victory.

1. Affirm 2 Chron 20:21 (NKJV and NIV): Give thanks to the Lord, for His mercy and love endure forever.
