- Affirm constantly!
- Your Word is a Lamp to my feet and a Light to my path.
- Direct my steps by Your Word.

E. AFFIRMATIONS: OLD TESTAMENT (in order of appearance) (in Amplified Classic Translation, unless specified otherwise)

- Deuteronomy 8:18
- But you shall [earnestly] remember the Lord your God, for it is He Who gives you power to get wealth, that He may establish His covenant which He swore to your fathers, as it is this day.

• Deuteronomy 28:1-2

If you will listen diligently to the voice of the Lord your God, being watchful to do all His commandments which I command you this day, the Lord your God will set you high above all the nations of the earth.

2 And all these blessings shall come upon you and overtake you if you heed the voice of the Lord your God.

- Joshua 1:8
- This Book of the Law shall not depart out of your mouth, but you shall meditate on it day and night, that you may observe *and* do according to all that is written in it. For then you shall make your way prosperous, and then you shall deal wisely *and* have good ^[a]success.
- a. <u>Joshua 1:8</u> This is the only place in the early English versions where the word "success" is found. The secret of success is given in verses 5 through 9. Joshua accepted Moses' place of leadership without misgivings. God's will for him was his will, and he did not hesitate. To go "all out" for God was already habitual with him; it is the unfailing prerequisite of eternal success (Deut. 6:3-5; Ps. 1:1-3; Luke 10:25-28).
- Psalm 1:3b
- everything he does shall prosper [and come to maturity].

- Psalm 35:27
- Let those who favor my righteous cause *and* have pleasure in my uprightness shout for joy and be glad and say continually, Let the Lord be magnified, Who takes pleasure in the prosperity of His servant.

- Psalm 112:3
- Prosperity and welfare are in his house, and his righteousness endures forever.



- Psalm 115:14-15
- May the Lord give you increase more and more, you and your children.
- May you be blessed of the Lord, Who made heaven and earth!

- Psalm 118:25
- Save now, we beseech You, O Lord; send now prosperity, O Lord, we beseech You, *and* give to us success!

- Proverbs 3:9-10
- Honor the Lord with your capital *and* sufficiency [from righteous labors] and with the firstfruits of all your income;
- So shall your storage places be filled with plenty, and your vats shall be overflowing with new wine.

- Proverbs 8:18
- Riches and honor are with me, enduring wealth and righteousness (uprightness in every area and relation, and right standing with God).

- Proverbs 10:4
- He becomes poor who works with a slack *and* idle hand, but the hand of the diligent makes rich.
- •
- Proverbs 11:24-25
- There are those who [generously] scatter abroad, and yet increase more; there are those who withhold more than is fitting *or* what is justly due, but it results only in want.
- The liberal person shall be enriched, and he who waters shall himself be watered.

- Proverbs 13:4
- The appetite of the sluggard craves and gets nothing, but the appetite of the diligent is abundantly supplied.

- Proverbs 13:18
- Poverty and shame come to him who refuses instruction *and* correction, but he who heeds reproof is honored.

- Proverbs 13:22 KJV
- A good man leaveth an inheritance to his children's children: and the wealth of the sinner is laid up for the just.



- Proverbs 14:23
- In all labor there is profit, but idle talk leads only to poverty.

- Proverbs 15:16
- Better is little with the reverent, worshipful fear of the Lord than great *and* rich treasure and trouble with it.

- Proverbs 22:4
- The reward of humility *and* the reverent *and* worshipful fear of the Lord is riches and honor and life.

- Isaiah 1:19
- If you are willing and obedient, you shall eat the good of the land;

F. AFFIRMATIONS: NEW TESTAMENT (in order of appearance) (in Amplified Classic Translation unless specified otherwise)

- Matthew 6:33
- But seek (^[a]aim at and strive after) first of all His kingdom and His righteousness (^[b]His way of doing and being right), and then all these things ^[c]taken together will be given you besides.
- •
- Mark 11:24
- For this reason I am telling you, whatever you ask for in prayer, believe (trust and be confident) that it is granted to you, and you will [get it].
- •
- Luke 6:38
- Give, and [gifts] will be given to you; good measure, pressed down, shaken together, and running over, will they pour ^[a]into [the pouch formed by] the bosom [of your robe and used as a bag]. For with the measure you deal out [with the measure you use when you confer benefits on others], it will be measured back to you.

- John 14:14
- [Yes] I will grant [I Myself will do for you] whatever you shall ask in My Name [as ^[a]presenting all that I Am].



- Romans 13:8
- Keep out of debt *and* owe no man anything, except to love one another; for he who loves his neighbor [who practices loving others] has fulfilled the Law [relating to one's fellowmen, meeting all its requirements].

- 2 Corinthians 9:6-8
- [Remember] this: he who sows sparingly *and* grudgingly will also reap sparingly *and* grudgingly, and he who sows generously [^[a]that blessings may come to someone] will also reap generously *and* with blessings.
- Let each one [give] as he has made up his own mind *and* purposed in his heart, not reluctantly *or* sorrowfully or under compulsion, for God loves (He ^b takes pleasure in, prizes above other things, and is unwilling to abandon or to do without) a cheerful (joyous, "prompt to do it") giver [whose heart is in his giving].
- And God is able to make all grace (every favor and ^[c]earthly blessing) come to you in abundance, so that you may always *and* under all circumstances *and* whatever the need ^[d]be self-sufficient [possessing enough to require no aid or support and furnished in abundance for every good work and charitable donation].

• 2 Corinthians 9:9-10

- As it is written, He [the benevolent person] scatters abroad; He gives to the poor; His deeds of justice and goodness and kindness and benevolence will go on and endure forever!
- And [God] Who provides seed for the sower and bread for eating will also provide and multiply your [resources for] sowing and increase the fruits of your righteousness [^[a]which manifests itself in active goodness, kindness, and charity].

• Ephesians 3:20-21

- Now to Him Who, by (in consequence of) the [action of His] power that is at work within us, is able to [carry out His purpose and] do superabundantly, far over *and* above all that we [dare] ask or think [infinitely beyond our highest prayers, desires, thoughts, hopes, or dreams]—
- To Him be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations forever and ever. Amen (so be it).

- Philippians 4:19
- And my God will liberally supply ([a]fill to the full) your every need according to His riches in glory in Christ Jesus.



- 1 Timothy 6:17-19
- As for the rich in this world, charge them not to be proud *and* arrogant *and* contemptuous of others, nor to set their hopes on uncertain riches, but on God, Who richly *and* ceaselessly provides us with everything for [our] enjoyment.
- [Charge them] to do good, to be rich in good works, to be liberal *and* generous of heart, ready to share [with others],
- In this way laying up for themselves [the riches that endure forever as] a good foundation for the future, so that they may grasp that which is life indeed.

- 3 John 1:2
- Beloved, I pray that you may prosper in every way and [that your body] may keep well, even as [I know] your soul keeps well *and* prospers.

- He who is victorious shall inherit all these things, and I will be God to him and he shall be My son.
