1. Trust God's Timing
2. Prevent the enemy's ambush.
3. Build sensitivity to the Holy Spirit
4. Transform limiting thoughts into bold faith actions.

7. Seek mentorship from the natural and the supernatural.

Review of Part 3

D. God Has Already Started the Turnarounds.

1. Expect a fantastic year.
 - a. The Lord is positioning you for a year of steady, continual progress.
2. Progress may not be a sprint, but it will be consistent.
 - a. You will see improvement unfolding step by step.
3. Hab 2:3 shows that the vision will come to pass.
 - a. The vision is appointed for a future time and will not fail.
 - b. Even when delays appear, wait patiently knowing it will come.
 - c. Press toward the mark until the blessing arrives.
 - d. The enemy will try to limit your thoughts with “you can’t.”
 - e. But God says, “You can,” and He expects bold, faith-filled action.
 - f. Every challenge is an opportunity for advancement.
4. When you ask God for strength, He empowers you and guides you how to overcome every obstacle and challenge.
5. When you ask God for wisdom, He will reveal the solution and equip you to solve it with confidence.
6. Skills develop through practice.
 - a. You grow by working through challenges, not avoiding them.
 - b. Repetition builds mastery.
7. Adversity is a chance to improve yourself.
 - a. Every difficulty becomes training for your next level. God uses pressure to produce power.
8. Rom 12:12, Rejoicing in hope, patient in tribulation, continuing steadfastly in prayer.
 - a. Make the effort to rejoice despite demonic attacks.

- b. Rejoice in hope.
- c. Be patient and endure challenges of tribulation.
- d. Continue steadfastly in prayer with persistence and perseverance.
- e. The enemy only wins if you quit, so refuse to quit.
- f. Those who diligently seek God first will experience victory in this season.
- g. God commands you not to fear because He is present with you, strengthening and upholding you with His righteous right hand (Is 41:10).

9. The first and greatest commandment (Matt 22:37): "Love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind."

- a. Why Love is the greatest commandment.
 - 1) Love leaves no room for fear because love commits fully.
 - 2) Love supports others through weaknesses and flaws.
 - 3) 1 Pet 4:8 says, "Love covers a multitude of sins," because true agape, godly love stays constant even when people fall in their imperfection.
 - 1) God is patient with us; we must be patient with others.
 - 2) When you walk in God's love, fear cannot infiltrate because trust is fully anchored in Him.
 - 3) Have faith in God and trust that He's helping us through it, regardless what it looks like, feels like, sounds like, smells like, or seems like.

10. A David and Goliath New Year Analogy

- a. David had no fear because he was trained long before the battle.
- b. You have been trained to conquer any spiritual Goliaths.
- c. Like Esther, you have been prepared "for such a time as this."
- d. Defeat your Goliath-like challenges and watch the enemy scatter.
- e. The Philistines fled from David in fear.
- f. When you defeat your Goliath-like demons, devils, and evil spirits, everything that once harassed you will flee from your life.
- h. Go forward with no fear and put the fear back on the enemy.
- i. Defeat every Goliath-like challenge by slinging the Word of God and walking in God's fearless, perfect love.

Part 4

E. Invincible Faith for Turnarounds, Breakthroughs, and Victories

1. Google's Definition of "Invincible" = "Too powerful to be defeated or overcome."

2. Affirm: In the Name of Jesus, I am made in the image of an invincible God, so I have His invincible nature and His invincible faith.
3. Affirm: In the Name of Jesus, I have invincible faith in my invincible God, according to Mk 11:22.
4. Affirm: In the Name of Jesus, God has given me a measure of His invincible faith, according to Rom 12:3.
5. Affirm: In the Name of Jesus, now my invincible faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen, according to Heb 11:1.
6. In the Name of Jesus, I have invincible faith as a mustard seed and I say say to this mountain of challenge(s) of _____, “Move from here to there,” and it will move; and nothing will be impossible for me because me and my God are too powerful to be defeated or overcome, according to Matt 17:20.
7. Faith is trusting God, moving forward, and knowing He is with you.
 - a. The battle is in your mind; fear causes faith to waver.
 - b. In battle, reject to fear because fear opens the door to dread.
 - c. Close that door by stopping fear and stepping back into faith.
9. 1 John 4:18, There is no fear in love; but perfect love casts out fear, because fear involves torment. But he who fears has not been made perfect in love.
 - a. Get fear out of your mind and thoughts.
10. Fear attracts problems, but invincible faith pushes them away.
11. Focus your thoughts of God’s perfect love so fear is removed from your mind.
 - a. Focus on thoughts that are in the godly Mind of Christ.
 - b. Resist the enemy’s lying thoughts.
 - c. Declare, “I will not let the devil scare me.”
12. Sins and Mindsets to Avoid
 - a. Treat these as sins to avoid because they open the door to fear and may be a challenge to weaken your faith.
 - 1) Regurgitating negative thoughts
 - 2) The urge to keep talking about the challenge
 - 3) The desire to justify your wrong decision or sin
 - 4) Feeling guilty
 - 5) Feeling bad because of strife
13. Submit to God’s Word train your mind to think on what is good, pure, and aligned with scripture.
14. Don’t let the enemy weaken your confidence in God and His Word.

15. Faith and fear cannot operate together.
 - a. If fear is present, faith is inactive.
16. Fear is the enemy of your faith.
17. Become skilled at identifying fears that still try to hide in your life.
 - a. Many people don't recognize fears because they are disguised.
 - b. Admit your fears when you become aware of them.
18. Ask the Holy Spirit to reveal all fears.
19. Fear is not your DNA; God gave you a spirit of power, not fear.
20. Put your shield of faith up around your life, property, finances, and family.
 - a. Fiery darts may still come, but your shield bubble can quench them.
21. If you give in to fear and it infiltrates, it can penetrate the protective shield bubble that covers and surrounds you.
 - a. Fiery darts can get through once fear is operating.
 - b. When that happens, close that breach or crack in your protective bubble by confessing the sin of fear, repent, renounce, and break curses (CRRB). receive forgiveness, forgive yourself and/or others.
22. Immediately after your CRRB, re-establish the Kingdom of God through saying the Kingdom of God Prayer.
23. In the Kingdom of God protection, you have full spiritual communication signal directly to the private line to the Throne Room of God.
24. Ps 68:1, "Let God arise, let His enemies be scattered; let those also who hate Him flee before Him."
25. You are the light of the world (Matt 5:14)
 - a. Turn your spiritual light switch on because light drives out darkness.
 - b. God's perfect love drives out fear.
 - c. When fear tries to attach and dim your light, strengthen your faith by hearing the Word of God and speak affirmations to shine even brighter!

Affirm: In the Name of Jesus, God has given me His invincible faith for turnarounds, breakthroughs, and victories. His faith in me is too powerful to be defeated or overcome. His perfect love casts fear out of my life and empowers me to move forward with boldness, joy, and strength. Amen.
