

## Turn It Around for Good Series – Part 9 Decree Your Turnaround

### Part 8 Review and Summary:

#### **I. Speak Your Turnaround into Existence**

1. Your words activate the power of Jesus in your life.
  - a. Your turnaround begins when your mouth agrees with what God has promised, not with what fear suggests.
2. Follow the example of the woman who spoke her faith before she touched Jesus.
  - a. She kept declaring her belief until her words pulled her miracle into manifestation.
  - b. Her turnaround began with her confession, not her contact.
  - c. Your turnaround begins the same way, speak what you believe, not what you fear.
3. Faith-filled words draw heaven's attention and open the way for immediate change.
  - a. What looks like an interruption may actually be divine intervention.
  - b. Jesus stopped for the woman because faith always gets His attention.
4. Speak life the way Jesus did when others spoke death.
  - a. Jesus refused to agree with the fearful report surrounding Jairus' daughter.
  - b. He ignored ridicule and declared life where others declared finality.
  - c. Negative words empower stress and defeat.
  - d. Your words fill your life with the fruit you speak—life or death, victory or defeat.
5. Speak with the authority demonstrated by the Centurion.
  - a. He believed that one spoken word carried unstoppable authority.
  - b. Jesus called this "great faith" because he trusted the power of a decree.
  - c. When you speak God's Word, you release the same authority into your situation.
6. Your words determine your miracle.
  - a. Jesus spoke life over Jairus' daughter.

- b. The woman with the issue of blood spoke healing over her own body.
- c. Both miracles reveal divine order and completion, symbolized by the number twelve.
- d. The Centurion spoke authority into his situation.
- e. You must speak your turnaround with the same boldness.
- f. When your words align with God’s Words, your miracle begins moving toward you.
- g. Your turnaround is voice-activated—speak it, believe it, and watch God do it!

## **Part 9**

### **J. Decree Your Turnaround**

- 1. Decree Your Turnaround
  - a. A decree is a commanding declaration that releases God’s authority into your situation.
  - b. Make your command once, and it stands.
  - c. Then continually affirm it afterward as your thanksgiving to God.
  - d. Heaven responds to your faith-filled affirmations.
  - e. Royalty makes decrees, and as an adult child of the King, you carry the authority to speak what heaven has established.
  - f. Making a decree is not arrogance; it’s your godly inheritance.
  - g. Scripture declares you are a royal priesthood and a co-heir with Christ, which means you carry the right and the authority to decree God’s will into your situation.
  - h. 1 Peter 2:9, “You are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people belonging to God.”
  - i. Romans 8:17, Believers are described as “heirs of God and co-heirs with Christ.”
- 2. When you decree God’s promises, you set divine order into motion.
  - a. Refuse to speak the language of perishing (Mark 4:35-41).
  - b. In verse 38, while in the storm, the disciples cried, “Master, do You not care that we perish?”
  - c. In verse 39, Jesus rebuked the storm; but He also demonstrated how to overcome the storm by decreeing a turnaround with His words.

- d. Fear says, "I'm perishing."
  - e. Faith says, "I'm overcoming."
  - f. Your turnaround accelerates when you stop speaking fear and start speaking victory.
3. Your words become the catalyst for your breakthrough.
- a. Your godly words initiate, accelerate, and intensify divine change.
  - b. The Blood of Jesus covers you.
  - c. The Word of God empowers you.
  - d. Your confession releases your turnaround.
  - e. When your words echo God's Words of Truth, the entire direction of your life shifts into alignment with the Kingdom of God.
4. Because you are a co-heir with Christ, you have been given a future that cannot be denied.
- a. Your inheritance includes victory, not defeat.
  - b. Make your decree from a place of ownership, not doubt and fear.
  - c. What God has called you to do cannot be stolen, silenced, or stopped.
  - d. Your decree announces to the spirit realm that you are taking dominion over what already belongs to you.
5. Your decree positions you to claim what has been commanded to be released to you from heaven.
- a. Job 22:28, "You will also declare a thing, and it will be established for you."
  - b. When you decree your turnaround, you are declaring that what was spoken has already been given to you.
  - c. **An example of a decree:** In the Name of Jesus, I decree God's Word over this challenge that:  
My God has already supplied my need that my electric bill has been paid on time.
