Part 9 Review and Summary:

J. Decree Your Turnaround

1. A decree releases your godly authority as a commanding declaration that releases your godly authority into your situation.
2. Once a decree is made; then you should affirm it as a thanksgiving until the delivery of that decree has manifested on earth from Heaven.
3. Your royal identity gives you decreeing authority because, as God's chosen generation, His royal priesthood, and co-heirs with Christ, you are commanded by God to speak His Word over every situation on the earth.
4. Jesus demonstrated that turnaround power is released with faith-filled words, not with fear-filled negative words.
5. The Blood of Jesus covers you, the Word of God empowers you, and your confession causes your turnaround.
6. Your decree announces to the spirit realm that you have taken your godly dominion over what already belongs to you.
7. Personal decrees activate personal breakthroughs.
8. **An example of a decree:** In the Name of Jesus, I decree God's Word over this challenge declaring: That my God has already supplied my need and my electric bill has been paid on time.

Part 10

K. Stewarding Your Turnaround

1. God's turnaround produces supernatural acceleration.
 - a. Amos 9:13a says, "Behold, the days are coming," says the Lord, "When the plowman shall overtake the reaper..."
 - b. The Prophet Amos prophesied a season of supernatural acceleration where the harvest overtakes the planting.
 - c. When God releases a turnaround, He compresses seasons so the "super" over the natural produces a supernatural acceleration, causing the harvest to come exponentially faster than expected.
 - d. Your turnaround is not meant to advance slowly; it is designed to be miraculously catapulted forward.
 - e. The plowman overtaking the reaper reveals continuous fruitfulness.
 - f. There is no downtime, no loss, no delay.
 - g. What once took years now happens in moments.
2. Overflow is the evidence of divine restoration.
 - a. Amos 9:13c says, "The mountains shall drip with sweet wine, and all the hills shall flow with it."
 - b. God's turnaround is expressed by a visible overflow of abundance, blessings, wealth, and health.
 - c. It is undeniable proof that the source is God Himself, not human effort, because only He can release increase that surpasses every natural limitation.
 - d. Sweet wine in this scriptural passage represents restored joy, not merely the return of stolen or lost assets or resources.
3. Turnaround includes rebuilding what was lost.
 - a. Amos 9:14b says, "They shall build the waste cities and inhabit them.
 - b. God rebuilds what looked ruined beyond repair.
 - c. God restores what the enemy has broken.
 - d. God makes what was abandoned fully habitable again.

4. Your decrees produce harvests of answered prayers.
 - a. Amos 9:14c-d says, “They shall plant vineyards and drink wine from them; they shall also make gardens and eat fruit from them.”
5. Sustaining the turnaround requires faithful stewardship.
 - a. A decree initiates the turnaround, but stewardship sustains it.
 - b. You steward your turnaround with continued faith-filled words.
 - c. You steward it by obedience, consistency, and gratitude.
 - d. You steward it by refusing to return to old mindsets.
6. God Establishes What He Restores.
 - a. Amos 9:15 says, “I will plant them in their land, and no longer shall they be pulled up from the land I have given them,” says the Lord your God.
 - b. This is a promise of permanence.
 - c. No more instability.
 - d. No more cycles of loss.
 - e. No more fear of reversal.
 - f. God does not just bless you, He roots you.
 - g. Your turnaround is protected by a covenant promise.
 - h. What God establishes, no one can uproot.
 - i. The phrase “says the Lord your God” seals the promise.
 - j. This turnaround is not conditional on circumstances.
 - k. It is not temporary.
 - l. It is anchored in your covenant rights, not in your performance.
7. As you make decrees, you will take more dominion for the Kingdom of God.
 - a. Godly stewardship empowers you to possess new and restored assets.
 - b. It also protects and preserves them so your dominion continues to increase.
 - c. Move from speaking victory to walking in it.
 - d. Move from believing for it to living in it.
 - e. Move from breakthrough to dominion.

8. Living in continuous harvest means your new normal becomes a daily lifestyle marked by frequent and multiple miracles.
 - a. Stewarding your turnaround activates a Kingdom principle of planting seeds with every decree.
 - b. Stewarding your turnaround constantly waters those decreed seeds with biblical affirmations.
 - c. Stewarding your turnaround consistently reaps a godly harvest.
 - d. Stewarding your turnaround expands the reach of God's Kingdom.
 - e. Stewarding your turnaround brings you into overflow so you can bless others.
9. **Say this Decree for Stewarding Your Turnaround Only Once:**
In the Name of Jesus, I release a *Decree for Stewarding My Turnaround*, declaring that God is bringing me into supernatural acceleration, divine restoration, abundant overflow, supernatural harvests, godly dominion, authority, power, and continuous, never-ceasing miracles according to Amos 9:13-15. Amen.
10. **Say this Daily Affirmation for Stewarding My Turnaround Frequently:**
In the Name of Jesus, I affirm that my turnaround is moving me into supernatural acceleration, divine restoration, abundant overflow, supernatural harvests, godly dominion, authority, power, and continuous, never-ceasing miracles according to Amos 9:13–15.
