F. The Holy Spirit's Mentorship Through the Fruit of the Spirit

1. Gal 5:22–23, “But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, gentleness, goodness, faith, humility, and self-control. Against such things there is no law.”
2. The Holy Spirit mentors us through the Fruit He produces in us.
3. His leadership is not just directional; it is transformational so we learn how to behave in God's character.
4. God's Fruit makes us more powerful invincible Ambassadors of God.
5. Be led by the Spirit of God, according to Rom 8:14:
“For those who are led by the Spirit of God are the children of God.”
 - a. Love teaches you how to maneuver through relationships without fear and keeps your heart aligned with purity and godliness.
 - b. Joy strengthens you and keeps you from quitting.
 - c. Peace stabilizes you and enables you to overcome every storm.
 - d. Patience slows you down so you don't outrun God, and it protects you from rushing so you do things in God's right timing.
 - e. Gentleness keeps your heart softened and sensitive to the Holy Spirit.
 - f. Goodness shapes your actions so they reflect God's character of how you treat others.
 - g. Faithfulness keeps you committed to God's path and confident in His leading.
 - h. Humility enables you to be surrendered, teachable, and leadable.
 - i. Self-control helps to dominate your flesh so the Holy Spirit can lead you and encourage you to stop grabbing the wheel when God is driving.
6. Stop being a backseat driver, let God show you how to maneuver as you drive through life's journey.
 - a. Ask God to show you each path to take.
 - b. Let Him be your navigator through every stormy challenge.
 - c. God gives you the wheel so you can follow His narrow road.
7. You cannot ask God to bless a path He did not choose.
 - a. God cannot bless something He is not doing.
 - b. Find out what He is doing because it is already blessed and follow Him.
 - c. If you must ask for something to be blessed, it wasn't His path.
8. Release control and follow His lead.
