

Back to Basics – Partnering with God

Overview: God has designed us for Him. We are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works. The unique aspect of partnering with God is that his part is already done. He is waiting for us. All that God wants to do for us and through us is in our hands. We are the initiator; we set the pace.

A. Hearing and Doing Is a Biblical Imperative.

1. If ye will obey my voice, and keep my commandments... Ex 19:5
2. Hear therefore, O Israel, and observe to do it. Deut 6:1-3
3. If you shall hearken diligently unto the voice of the Lord thy God, to observe and to do all his commandments... Deut 28:1-2
4. Whosoever heareth these sayings of mine, and doeth them... Matt 7:24-27
5. Be ye doers of the word, and not hearers only. Jam 1:22-25
6. Blessed are they that hear the word of God and keep it. Luk 11:28

B. Doing the Will of God.

1. Not everyone who says unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter the kingdom of heaven, but he that doeth the will of my Father in heaven. Mat 7:21
2. For whosoever shall do the will of my Father, the same is my brother, and sister, and mother. Mat 12:50
3. If any man will do his will, he shall know the doctrine, whether it be of God. Joh 7:17
4. Now may the God of peace...make you perfect in every good work to do his will, working in you that which is well pleasing. Heb 13:20-21
5. We do not cease to pray for you and to desire that ye might be filled with the knowledge of his will...that ye might walk worthy of the Lord. Col 1:9-10

C. He Who Loves Me, Keeps My Commandments.

1. If you love me, keep my commandments. Joh 14:15
2. He that hath my commandments, and keeps them, he it is that loveth me: and he that loveth me shall be loved by my Father, and I will love him, and manifest myself to him. Joh 14:21
3. If a man love me, he will keep my words: and my Father will love him, and we will come unto him, and make our abode with him. Joh 14:23
4. He that loveth me not keepeth not my sayings. Joh 14:24
5. For whosoever will be ashamed of me and my words, of him shall the Son of man be ashamed. Luk 9:26

D. Consecrate Your Whole Being.

1. I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God. Rom 12:1
2. If any man will come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily, and follow me. For whosoever will save his life shall lose it: but whosoever will lose his life for my sake, the same will save it. Luke 9:23-24
3. But he turned, and said to Peter, Get thee behind me, Satan: thou art an offense to me: for thou savourest not the things of God, but of men. Mat 16:23

E. Partnering with God to Change the World Around Us.

1. We are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them. Eph 2:10
2. We have been called, we have been given an inheritance, and we have all the dunamis power needed to accomplish his will. Eph 1:17-23
3. He has raised us up together, and made us sit together in heavenly places in Christ Jesus, far above any of the wiles of the enemy. Eph 2:6
4. Understand who you are in Christ and who Christ is in you. You are the Glorious Church. You are the Manifested Child of God. You can do what Jesus has done and greater things.
5. In the New Covenant, we have been given every blessing, every promise, and every benefit to be and to do everything he has called us to be and do.
6. Spend time with God daily, in His Word, and in prayer to hear His voice. Then go and take your authority to pray what he says to pray and do what He says to do.
