

Rate Yourself in the Fruit of the Spirit – Generational – Part 8a

Introduction

1. We are going to grade ourselves based on words and attitudes expressed in each scenario.
A+ = Extraordinary
A = Excellent
B+ = Very Good
B = Good
C = Fair
D = Do Better
F = Fell Short
2. The purpose of this exercise is to see where you are NOW spiritually compared to where you WERE and where you WANT to be.
3. Be honest with yourself about the level that truly reflects your current responses.

A. New Scenario – Generational

1. Question: Person A in this scenario is an ABCer from ABC Church. Person A was called to pray for Person B, her mother. Her mother needed healing for severe knee pain. After Person A prayed over the phone for her mother's knee pain, the challenge improved and was not as severe. She also became peaceful as the anxiety and stress left. Person A was also having knee challenges, but not as severe as her mother's. Person A had been standing in faith for healing. Afterward, Person A continued doing household chores and got on her knees to clean the baseboards. When Person A finished that chore, her knees became swollen and very painful. Person A repented for not asking the Holy Spirit whether she should have done that and confessed that sin by CRRBing because she had overworked herself by being on her knees for too long. She didn't take a break in between to stretch her knees out and relieve the pressure. Person A prayed Healing School Level 3 prayers and affirmed many Rapid-fire affirmations but received little result.

The Holy Spirit brought to her remembrance the phone conversation she had earlier with her mother, Person B. The Holy Spirit revealed to Person A that her knee challenge was generational. So, Person A broke curses related to generational knee challenges and any generational fear connected to them. She also did more Rapid-fire affirmations. In addition, she attended The Morning Miracle's Awake 6:33 a.m. Prayer Sessions and Impartation to pray those prayers and affirmations as well as receive a daily Impartation of God's anointing. She was finally able to get to a Zero level of pain and had received a complete healing!

Based on this scenario, what grade would you give Person A and yourself if you were in her position?

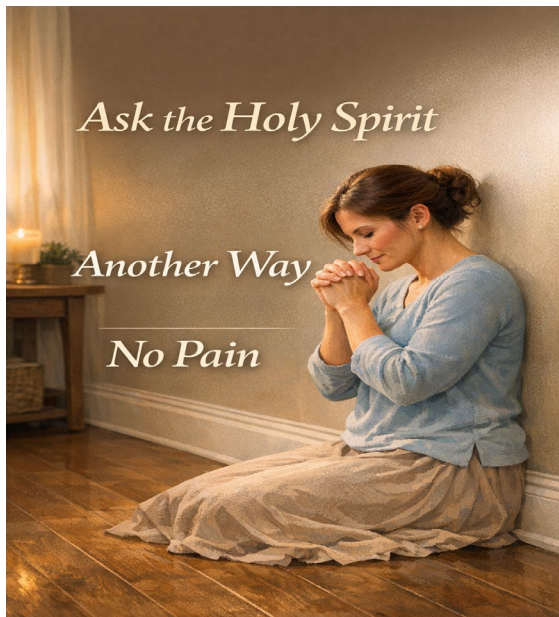
Answer #1: B



Person A was obedient to God’s Word by praying for Person B, her mother, who was experiencing knee pain.

Scripture: James 5:16

“Confess your trespasses to one another, and pray for one another, that you may be healed. The effective, fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much.”



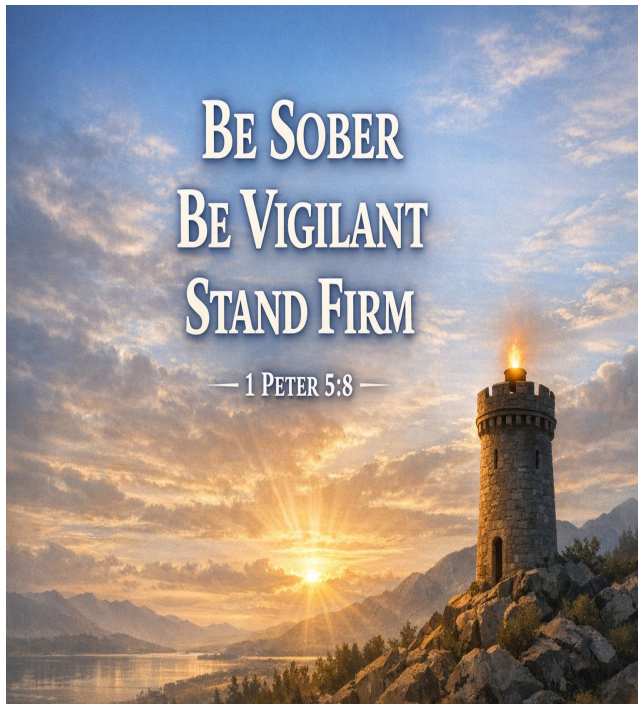
However, the reason Person A did not receive an A rating is that she person fell short by not asking the Holy Spirit whether she should have gotten on her knees to clean the baseboards. The Holy Spirit could have shown Person A another way to get the job done that would not have caused any pain.

Scripture: John 14:27

“But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name, He will teach you all things, and bring to your remembrance all things that I said to you.”



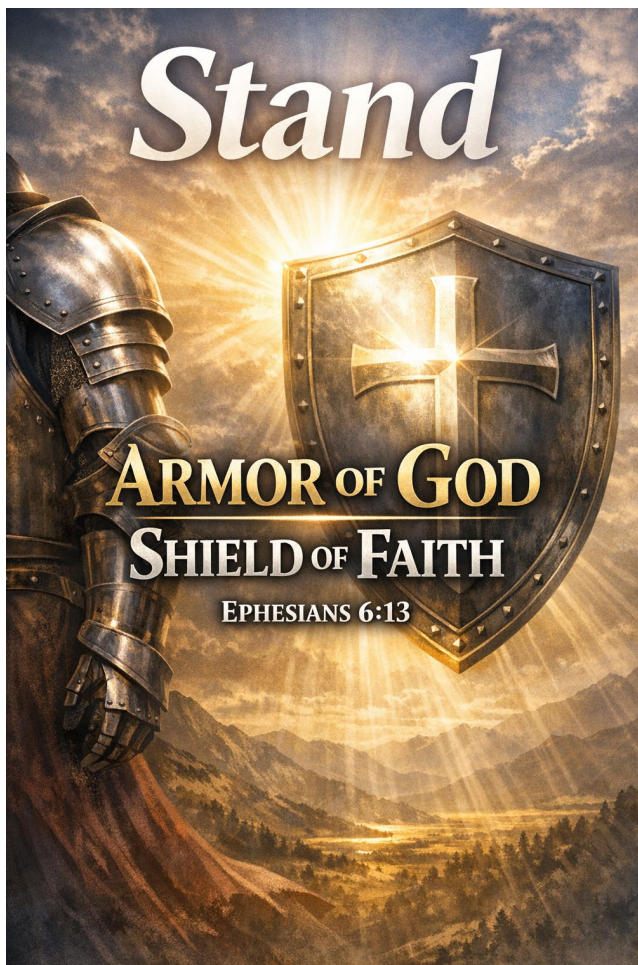
This was also a sin of self-injury, which is rooted in self-hatred. It is recommended to also break generational curses in these areas. Perhaps the family member’s knee challenges came from the same root. Let’s use a tree as an example: the branches could represent the injury (or injuries, if this is recurring), the trunk could represent the sin of self-injury, and the roots start with self-hatred. There could also be deeper roots of generational self-hatred, generational fear of self-hatred, and related challenges.



However, just because you broke curses does not mean the devil won't try to attack in these areas again. For example, just because you broke a curse of self-injury and generational self-injury, does not mean that same sin will not try to attack again through another lying injury challenge. But because you broke the generational curses, the hooks are gone, and now it can be stopped with the scriptural spiritual warfare prayers and affirmations that ABC teaches.

Scripture: 1 Peter 5:8

“Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil walks about like a roaring lion, seeking whom he may devour.”



Continually “stand” with your Armor of God on and your Shield of Faith raised against the flaming arrows of the wicked one.

- Stay in the anointing by taking advantage of joining **The Morning Miracle's 6:33 a.m. Prayer Session and TTPM** in the morning.
- Do your set of USPs, KOGs, and Mini Scenarios frequently throughout the day as an act of spiritual warfare.
- That way, you'll be more in tune with the Holy Spirit and better able to ambush the devil's ambush, recognize the enemy's sneak attacks and gain more victories.
