Understanding the Anointing in You

Overview: The Holy Spirit, Who is the source of the anointing, dwells in your spirit for the specific purpose of empowering you to accomplish the plan which God has for your life.

A. The Anointing in you is the glory of God.	
1. The glory is the manifested presence of God.	2 Chr 5:14
a) You are the temple of God.	1 Cor 3:16
b) The Holy Spirit dwells in you.	1 Cor 6:19
c) He will never leave you nor forsake you.	Heb 13:5
2. The anointing is the presence of God manifested for a specific purpose.	Luke 5:17
a) The anointing abideth in you.	1 John 2:27
b) The same Spirit Who raised Christ from the dead dwells in you.	Rom 8:11
c) The hidden mystery is Christ in you, the hope of glory.	Col 1:26,27
3. The anointing changes us into manifested (mature & productive) sons of God.	Rom 8:19
a) To know the riches of His glory in the saints.	Eph 1:17
b) To present to Himself a glorious church, not having spot nor wrinkle.	Eph 5:27
c) To have you walking in love, filled with the fullness of God.	Eph 3:19
B. The Anointing changes you from the inside to the outside.	
1. The first change is that your spirit is born again into the family of God.	
a) You are a new creation. All things have passed away.	2 Cor 5:17
b) Because of grace, you are blessed with all spiritual blessings.	Eph 1:3
c) You move more and more into the fullness of your inheritance	Gal 4:1-7
as God's anointing changes you from the inside outwards.	
2. The changes continue outwards so that all you need for life and godliness	2 Pet 1:3
becomes reality as:	
a) Your mind is renewed to the Word of God	Rom 12:2
(i.e., you start to think more and more with the Mind of Christ).	1 Cor 2:16
b) Your heart is purified by the engrafted Word	Jam 1:21
(i.e., Christ dwells more and more in your heart).	Eph 3:17
c) Your words are pleasing to God	Ps 19:14
(i.e., more and more you are justified by the words of your mouth).	Matt 12:37
3. The results of the changes include:	
a) You, the believer, becoming a super-conqueror.	Rom 8:37
b) You, the believer, reigning in life.	Rom 5:17
c) You receiving exceedingly abundantly above all you can ask or think.	Eph 3:20
C. God desires His glory to flow out of you.	
1. The glory of God flows out of you to reveal His glory.	1D / 17
a) Your final salvation is ready to be revealed in the last time (Amp).	1 Peter 1:5
b) You will rejoice with triumph when His glory shall be revealed.	1 Peter 4:13
c) We speak the wisdom of God unto glory (for our glorification – Amp).	1 Cor 2:4-10



2. The glory of God flows out of you to confirm who you are in Christ.

a) You live as an ambassador of Heaven.
b) You are to partake of His divine nature.
c) You are children of the Most High and you are gods.
1) Jesus said that the Scriptures call you "gods" and the Scriptures cannot be broken (i.e., be in error).
2 Cor 5:20
2 Peter 1:3,4
Psalm 82:6
Jn 10:34, 35

2) God made Moses a god unto Pharaoh.

Ex 7:1

- 3) Because of his sin, Adam's authority and dominion over the world was 2 Cor 4:4 lost to satan who, therefore, became the god of this world.
- 3. The Glory of God flows out of you to prepare you for the Ending Days.
 - a) Making you more Christ-like for, when He appears, **we shall be like Him.** 1 John 3:2-3 1Jn 3:2 Beloved, now are we the sons of God, and it doth not yet appear what we shall be: but we know that, when he shall appear, we shall be like him; for we shall see him as he is.
 - 1Jn 3:3 And every man that hath this hope in him purifieth himself, even as he is pure.
 - b) Revealing to us the power of knowing that in Him dwells the fullness of Col 2:9,10 the Godhead and **you are complete in Him** Who is the head of all principality and power.
 - c) Preparing you for the intimacy and friendship with God.
 - 1) Jesus wants you to be His friend.
 Joh 15:12 This is my commandment, That ye love one another, as I

- have loved you.

 Joh 15:13 Greater love hath no man than this, that a man lay down
- his life for his friends.
- Joh 15:14 Ye are my friends, if ye do whatsoever I command you.
- 2) Abide in Him and let His Words abide in you. John 15:7 Joh 15:4 Abide in me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, except it abide in the vine; no more can ye, except ye abide in me. Joh 15:5 I am the vine, ye are the branches: He that abideth in me, and I in him, the same bringeth forth much fruit: for without me ye can do nothing.

Joh 15:6 If a man abide not in me, he is cast forth as a branch, and is withered; and men gather them, and cast them into the fire, and they are burned.

Joh 15:7 If ye abide in me, and my words abide in you, ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done unto you.

3) You in me and I in you.

John 14:20

Joh 14:19 Yet a little while, and the world seeth me no more; but ye see me: because I live, ye shall live also.

Joh 14:20 At that day ye shall know that I am in my Father, and ye in me, and I in you.

Joh 14:21 He that hath my commandments, and keepeth them, he it is that loveth me: and he that loveth me shall be loved of my Father, and I will love him, and will manifest myself to him.
