

The Gifts of the Spirit – Part 2

The Three Power Gifts

Overview: We can walk in power to witness (Acts 1:8) to tell others about our faith and demonstrate the Kingdom of God (Jn 3:5, I Cor 4:20) when the Holy Spirit uses us to flow in the nine Gifts of the Spirit. (I Cor 12:1-13).

A. Operate in the 9 Gifts of the Spirit as He wills, not as we will. I Cor 12:11

B. The Three Power Gifts (Do)

- 1) The Gift of Faith – Is a divine increase of normal faith to a higher level I Cor 12:9; Acts 6:8
beyond human effort; it's a firm conviction of God's truth for a specific purpose, time, or place.

- 2) The Working of Miracles – God's dynamite power I Cor 12:10; Gal 3:5; Acts 6:8
that is an intervention in the course of nature and a sign of supernatural authority.
 - a) Supernatural dynamic acceleration of normalcy. Matt 8:14-15
 - b) Supernatural dynamic manifestation which humans cannot create. Matt 1:23

- 3) The Gifts of Healing – Saving from disease and its effects by curing and making one whole. I Cor 12:9; Matt 4:24

Recommendation: Yield to the Holy Spirit so His Gifts can flow through you to bless others.
