

Complete in Christ Jesus

Overview: Everything we need in this life to accomplish all the will of God for our life has been made available to us. God's Word tells us, "You are complete in Him." Let the truth of God's thoughts about you get down into the inside of you, into your heart. Out of the belief in your heart will come the confidence to do anything; for you can do all things through Christ because you are complete in Him.

A. Complete in Him (Col 2:9-10)

- 1. **Webster:** Complete 1. To finish; to end; to perfect; as, to complete a bridge, or an edifice; to complete an education. 2. To fill, to accomplish; as, to complete hopes or desires.3. To fulfil; to accomplish; to perform;
- 2. **Strongs:** pleroo (G4137) to make replete, that is, (literally) to cram (a net), level up (a hollow), or (figuratively) to *furnish* (or *imbue*, *diffuse*, *influence*), *satisfy*, *execute* (an office), *finish* (a period or task), *verify* (or *coincide* with a prediction), etc.: accomplish, (be) complete, end, expire, fill (up), fulfil, (be, make) full (come), fully preach, perfect, supply.
- 3. **Grammer:** Perfect Passive Indicative
 - a. Perfect completed action with lasting results in the present.
 - b. Passive the subject is acted upon.
 - c. Indicative the indicative mode is the form of the verb that indicates, that is, which affirms or denies; as, he writes, he is writing.
- 4. **Rendering:** And you are in Him (who has been filled with all the fullness of the Godhead bodily), having been filled fully and completely with the fullness that comes from His fullness, with the present result that you are in a state of fullness.
