

New Testament Sins

A. Old Testament (OT) Sins

1. Jesus paid for the remission of our sins.

Heb 9:15 And for this cause he is the mediator of the new testament, that by means of death, for the redemption of the transgressions that were under the **first testament**, they which are called might receive the promise of eternal inheritance.

2. OT sins violate the Law and Prophets' Teachings.

Luk 16:16 The law and the prophets were until John: since that time the kingdom of God is preached, and every man presseth into it.

3. OT sins violate the spirit of the law.

Mat 22:37-38 Jesus said unto him, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind. This is the first and great commandment.

Mat 22:39 And the second is like unto it, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself.

Mat 22:40 On these two commandments hang all the law and the prophets.

B. New Testament (NT) Sins

- 1. Two types of NT sins.
 - a) Sin not unto death.

1Jn 5:16a If any man see his brother sin a sin which is not unto death, he shall ask, and he shall give him life for them that sin not unto death.

b) Sin unto death.

1 Jn 5:16b There is a sin unto death: I do not say that he shall pray for it.

- 2. Sin not unto death.
 - a) Rom 14:23b for whatsoever is not of faith is sin.
 - b) Heb 11:6 But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him.
- 3. Sin unto death.
 - a) Manifestations of the sin unto death.
 - 1) Blaspheming the Holy Spirit.
 - Mat 12:31 Wherefore I say unto you, All manner of sin and blasphemy shall be forgiven unto men: but the blasphemy against the Holy Ghost shall not be forgiven unto men.
 - 2) Attributing the Work of the Holy Spirit to satan.
 - Act 4:13 And beholding the man which was healed standing with them, they could say nothing against it. Act 4:15 they conferred among themselves,
 - Act 4:16 Saying, What shall we do to these men? for that indeed a notable miracle hath been done by them is manifest to all them that dwell in Jerusalem; & we cannot deny it. Act 4:17 But that it spread no further among the people, let us straitly threaten them, that they speak henceforth to no man in this name.

Act 4:18 And they called them, and commanded them not to speak at all nor teach in the name of Jesus.

Act 18:6 And when they opposed themselves, and blasphemed, he shook his raiment, and said unto them, Your blood be upon your own heads; I am clean:

Mar 3:28 Verily I say unto you, All sins shall be forgiven unto the sons of men, and blasphemies wherewith soever they shall blaspheme:

Mar 3:29 But he that shall blaspheme against the Holy Ghost hath never forgiveness, but is in danger of eternal damnation: Mar 3:30 Because they said, He hath an unclean spirit.



- 3) Rejecting the Blood of Jesus.
 - Heb 10:29 Of how much sorer punishment, suppose ye, shall he be thought worthy, who hath trodden under foot the Son of God, and hath counted the blood of the covenant, where with he was sanctified, an unholy thing, and hath done despite (*i.e.*, *shown contempt*) unto the Spirit of grace?
- b) Effects (Wages) of the Sin unto Death.
 - Heb 10:26 For if we sin **willfully** (i.e., a deliberate informed choice; not by accident) after we have received the knowledge of the truth, there remains no more sacrifice for sins, Heb 10:27 But a certain fearful looking for of judgment and fiery indignation, which shall devour the adversaries.
 - Mat 7:21 Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven.
 - Mat 7:22 Many will say to me in that day, Lord, have we not prophesied in thy name? and in thy name have cast out devils? and in thy name done many wonderful works? Mat 7:23 I will profess to them, I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity.
 - Rev 14:9 And the third angel followed them, saying with a loud voice, If any man worship the beast and his image, and receive his mark in his forehead, or in his hand,
 - Rev 14:10 the same shall drink of the wine of the wrath of God, which is poured out without mixture into the cup of his indignation; and he shall be tormented with fire and brimstone in the presence of the holy angels, and in the presence of the Lamb:
 - Rev 14:11 the smoke of their torment ascends up for ever and ever & they have no rest day nor night, who worship the beast and his image, & whosoever receives the mark of his name.
 - Rev 20:4 And I saw thrones, and they sat upon them, and judgment was given unto them: and I saw the souls of them that were beheaded for the witness of Jesus, and for the word of God, and which had not worshipped the beast, neither his image, neither had received his mark upon their foreheads, or in their hands; and they lived and reigned with Christ a thousand years.
 - Rev 3:5 He that overcomes, the same shall be clothed in white raiment; & I will not blot out his name out of the book of life, but I will confess his name before my Father, and his angels.
- c) Conditions before one can commit the Sin unto Death.

 Heb 6:4-6 For it is impossible for those who were (1) once enlightened (Eph 4:18), and (2) have tasted of the heavenly gift (Rom 6:23), and (3) were made partakers of the Holy Ghost (Acts 11:16), and (4) have tasted the good word of God (Heb 5:14), and (5) the powers of the world to come (Rev 11:5), if they shall fall away, to renew them again unto repentance; seeing they crucify to themselves the Son of God afresh, and put him to an open shame.

C. Millennial Sins

- 1. Rev 2:27 Jesus is returning to rule with a rod of iron. No deviation from His Word.
- 2. The Age of the Millennium is comparable to the Age of Obedience in the Garden of Eden. Obedience is expected; on the day that one sins, one dies spiritually. The Second Death is the wages of sin during the Millennial Period.
- 3. Rev 21:7 He that overcomes shall inherit all things; I will be his God, and he shall be my son. Rev 21:8 But the fearful, and unbelieving, and the abominable, and murderers, and whoremongers, and sorcerers, and idolaters, and all liars, shall have their part in the lake which burneth with fire and brimstone: which is the second death.
