Overview: Believe that every one of God's Promises in the Bible can be yours. Then after accepting that Promise; sooner or later it will come. No where in the Bible on the teachings on prayer, does it say how long it takes for the promise to come. Mark 11:24 is the Prayer of Faith, which tells us "Therefore I say unto you, what things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them."
