### C. The Manifestation Balance

| 1) In receiving divine healing, there is a balance between hearing, speaking and doing.   |           |
| 2) Hearing: You cannot hear too much of the Word of God; but you can do too much relative to not speaking and not doing.          |           |
| a) If you hear and not do, you will fail sooner or later. Deut 18:1,2   | Dt 28:15  |
| b) So there is a point at which hearing alone will not help you.  | Jm 2:18   |
| c) If you draw back from hearing more about God, His soul takes no pleasure in you.   | Heb 10:38 |
| d) Remember, more knowledge of God and Jesus brings more grace.   | 2 Pet 1:2 |
| 3) Speaking – Your primary warfare is speaking. The Word of God, the Sword of the Spirit, Eph 6:17 is your only offensive weapon. |           |
| a) Praying to change circumstances includes speaking.   | Mt 6:7    |
| b) Your words move mountains and bring victories.   | Mk 11:23  |
| c) Your words guide your life by loosening into your life angels or demons.   | Pro 18:21 |
| d) Eventually, your words must be matched with action. There is a balance.  | Jm 2:20-3 |
| e) At some point without action, your words become empty, without <b>Godly</b> power.   | Jm 2:17   |
| 4) Actions – Faith without works is dead.   | Jm 2:14   |
| a) Actions speak better than words for they show the intent of your heart.  | 1 Jn 3:20 |
| b) God helps those who help themselves. It is a partnership as you draw closer together.  | Jm 4:8    |
| c) Every Prayer of Faith requires a Faith Action Plan.  | Mk 11:24  |
| 5) SeeSaw balance - On 1 side is Hearing and on the other are Speaking and Actions.   |           |
| a) Knowledge on one side is balanced by the product of action and speaking.   |           |
| b) Few words, much action.  |           |
| c) Many words, little action.   |           |
| d) In multiplication, if one variable is zero, the product of both is zero.   |           |
| e) We need to give God something to multiply. He is the God of the Increase.  | Ps 115:14 |
