

A Super-Conqueror's Prayer

Firstly, confess all your sins according to 1 John 1:9, then pray the following as an affirmation of God's Word, as a statement of your faith and as a prophetic declaration over your life. These words call those things that be not until they be (Rom 4:17); until they become reality in your life, body and ministry.

Heavenly Father, I thank You for Jesus Christ, Your Son. He is my Savior, my Lord, my Cleanser, my Deliverer, my strong tower, my strength, my personal bravery and my invincible army (Hab 3:19 Amp).

Jesus bore all my sins and nailed them to the cross so that I am the righteousness of God in Christ Jesus (2 Cor 5:21). So, in the Name of Jesus, I reckon (count) myself dead to sin but alive to God through Christ Jesus, my Lord (Rom 6:11).

Since Jesus bore my sins, then He also eliminated the wages of sins because it is illegal for two persons to pay the same price for the same offense (sin). In fact, not only did Jesus get rid of the wages of my sins for me, He also took those wages and paid the price for me.

Jesus bore in His body the wages of my sins, which are sickness, disease, pain, accidents, etc., which all lead to death. He also died for me so I should not die but live, and live in health. Therefore, I declare before Heaven, hell and earth that I have been healed by the stripes of Jesus and I shall live to be alive and remain until Jesus returns.

Jesus bore my sins in His body on the tree that I, being dead to sin, should live unto righteousness, by whose stripes I have been healed (1 Pet 2:24). Jesus paid the price that I should live a holy life, a righteous life, because my Father is Holy.

Therefore, I commit in my heart never to sin again. I ask You, Holy Spirit, to help me not to sin, to lead me not into temptation and to deliver me from evil. Should I sin, then I declare that a righteous person falls many times but the Lord always raises himr back up.

Jesus died for me and I was buried into His death by baptism but, as the glory of the Father raised Jesus from the dead, just so the glory of the Father keeps me walking in newness of life (Rom 6:4). For I am a new creation and old things have passed; all things have become new (2 Cor 5:17).



For the same Spirit, Who raised Jesus from the dead, dwells in me and quickens (gives life) to my mortal flesh (Rom 8:11). For Jesus is the Life and Life dwells in me and Life drives out death; so I will not die but I will be alive and remain until the second coming of the Messiah, my Lord Jesus.

For the Law of the Spirit of Life in Christ Jesus has set me free from the Law of sin and death (Rom 8:2). I don't have to sin; I don't have to pay the wages of sin; and I don't have to die. There is no condemnation for me (Rom 8:1). I am not on death row waiting to die, for Jesus has already paid the entire wages for all my sins.

I was crucified with Christ. Nevertheless, I live but not I; Christ Jesus lives in me and the life that I now live in the flesh, I live by the faith of the Son of God, Who loved me and gave Himself for me (Gal 2:20). Because Christ Jesus lives in me, I can do all things through Christ, Who strengthens me (Phil 4:13). I am more than a conqueror; I am a super-conqueror (Rom 8:37). I never fall (2 Pet 1:10).

Jesus is love, so I never fail (1 Cor 13:8). God and I are a majority and we can accomplish anything (Luke 1:37). My words move mountains and challenges (Mark 11:23). I am a person of great faith and nothing is impossible to me (Matt 17:20). I have been made rich by the poverty of Jesus (2 Cor 8:9).

My tongue is a tree of life (Pro 15:4) and so I speak life and not death (Pro 18:21) to myself, to my body, to my family, to my animals and plants, to those to whom I minister, and to my business and to my projects. God lives in my spirit and Christ dwells fully in my heart (Eph 3:17) and out of the abundance of my heart, I always speak God's Word, the Words of Life.

I am committed to being washed by the Water of the Word that I may be found without spot or wrinkle and be a part of the Glorious Church (Eph 5:26-27). In the Name of Jesus, I desire to be perfected by the five-fold ministry so that I may come together with those of like faith in the unity of the faith and of the knowledge of the Son of God, unto a perfect person unto the measure of Christ. (Eph 4:11-13).

In the Name of Jesus, I hide the Word in my heart, for the Word of God engrafted into my heart comes out of my mouth to set my soul free (James 1:21); and so, I desire that Christ dwells fully in my heart that I may know and walk in the love which passes understanding that I may be filled with the fullness of God (Eph 3:17-19).
