- 18) Tithing protects us and brings blessings.
- a) Tithe to your church. Malachi 3:10(AMP)
 - b) The devil wants to steal your blessing by compromising your tithe. John 10:10 (NKJV)
 - c) As a Tither, as long as you seek the Lord, by inquiring of Him and yearning for Him with all your heart, God will prosper you. 2 Chron 26:5(AMP)
 - d) Worship God with your Firstfruits or Tithes. 2 Chron 31:21
 - e) Honor the Lord with your Firstfruits. Deut 26:9-11 (AMP)
- 19) And all these blessings shall come upon you and overtake you, because you obey the voice of the Lord your God: Prov 3:9-10(NKJV)
- 20) Repent of worry; and seek God's Kingdom first. Deut 28:2(NKJV)
- 21) See yourself as a descendant of Abraham, an heir of the Covenant. Matt 6:31-33
- 22) God teaches you to profit. Acts 3:25(AMP)
- 23) It is God who gives you power to get wealth. Isaiah 48:17 (NKJV)
- 24) Give, and it will be given to you. Deut 8:18(NKJV)
- 25) It's so important that God reveals to you that you are an heir of God and a Joint-Heir with Christ that God mentions it 5 times. Eph 3:6, Gal 4:7, Rom 8:17(NKJV)
- 26) Generosity brings prosperity, especially in an economic drought. Luke 6:38(AMP)
- 27) God provide you with more than enough of every kind of grace. Rom 8:17, Gal 3:29, Prov 11:24-25(NKJV)
- 2 Cor 9:8(CEB)

D. As a King's Kid, you are "Good Enough."

- 1) You are an Ambassador of Christ. 2 Cor 5:20(NKJV)
- 2) God has made you a king (of a royal race) and a priest to our God. Rev 5:10 (NKJV,AMP)
And you shall reign on the earth.
- 3) Jesus is the King of Kings to those who are called, chosen and faithful. Rev 17:14(NKJV)
- 4) Renew your mind to see how much you have already been transformed. Rom 12:2(AMP)
 - a) Metamorphoō (Strong's Concordance G3339) = to change into another form, to transform, to transfigure. literally or figuratively, "metamorphose"
 - b) You can shine with the light of Jesus. Matt 17:2 (KJV)
 - c) You are changing from glory to glory. 2 Cor 3:18 (KJV)
