God's Garden

Overview: God created the Garden of Eden so that He could fellowship with mankind. Revelation 4:11b says, "Thou art worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honor and power: for thou hast created all things, and for thy pleasure they are and were created." This present world with sin will bring a penalty of destruction of the earth as we know it. There will be the "new heavens and a new earth (a New Eden), wherein dwelleth righteousness" according to 2 Peter 3:13. This is God's plan, purpose, and pleasure that you have dominion over 3 realms: that you can have dominion, not just over the Earth, but also the Heavens and the Underworld. Each believer is a part of God's garden; and His desire is to complete His will for you to be His garden of "Pleasure" called Eden, once again. (H5731 Hebrew for "Eden" means "Pleasure").

L. Maranatha! Our Lord Jesus cometh!

1 Cor 16:22b

(G3134 Greek for Maranatha means "Our Lord Jesus Cometh" and two Aramean words, Maran' athah, meaning, "our Lord comes," or is "coming." Another interpretation adopted meaning is, "Our Lord is coming, and He will judge those who have set him at nought.

1) Be ye also patient; stablish your hearts: for the coming of the Lord James 5:8 draweth nigh.

2) Grudge not one against another, brethren, lest ye be condemned: behold, James 5:9 the judge standeth before the door.

3) Let your moderation be known unto all men. The Lord is at hand. Phil 4:5 (G1933 Greek for "moderation" can be interpreted to mean "Appropriate patience.")
