

Do You Believe This?

Overview: Faith is our connection to all that God has done for us through Jesus. Faith is expressed through believing – acting on the faith in our hearts. Jesus asked this simple question to Martha after making a profound statement; Do you believe this? (John 11:26) Believing is the actions of the faith in our heart. Hear the Word \rightarrow hope is born \rightarrow faith takes root \rightarrow faith is expressed through believing.

Faith – **pistis (G4102) Noun** - From <u>G3982</u>; *persuasion*, that is, *credence*; moral *conviction* (of *religious* truth, or the truthfulness of God or a religious teacher), especially *reliance* upon Christ for salvation; abstractly *constancy* in such profession; by extension the system of religious (Gospel) *truth* itself: - assurance, belief, believe, faith, fidelity

Believe – pisteuo (G4100) Verb - From <u>G4102</u>; to *have faith* (in, upon, or with respect to, a person or thing), that is, *credit*; by implication to *entrust* (especially one's spiritual well being to Christ): - believe (-r), commit (to trust), put in trust with.
