

Living in the Anointing

A. Living in the Name of Jesus.

- 1. We have authority in three worlds.
 - Php 2:9 Wherefore God also hath highly exalted him, and given him a name which is above every name: Php 2:10 That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of things in heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth.
- 2. The authority is not available to the unbeliever.
 - Act 19:13 Then certain of the vagabond Jews, exorcists, took upon them to call over them which had evil spirits the name of the Lord Jesus, saying, We adjure you by Jesus whom Paul preacheth. Act 19:14 And there were seven sons of one Sceva, a Jew, and chief of the priests, which did so. Act 19:15 And the evil spirit answered and said, Jesus I know, and Paul I know; but who are ye? Act 19:16 And the man in whom the evil spirit was leaped on them, and overcame them, and prevailed against them, so that they fled out of that house naked and wounded.
- 3. The authority is accessed by believers through faith.
 - Act 3:16 His name **through faith** in his name hath made this man strong, whom ye see.
- 4. Faith is bounded by knowledge.
 - Hos 4:6 My people perish for lack of knowledge.
 - Heb 6:12 That ye be not slothful, but followers of them who through faith and patience inherit the promises.
- 5. Strong believers have more knowledge through strong meat and more faith by experience. Heb 5:14 But strong meat belongs to them that are of full age, even those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil.
- 6. Jesus has sent us in His Name.
 - Mar 16:17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;
 - Mar 16:18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.
- 7. In His Name
 - We have the Power of Attorney to use His Name.
 - We go as His Proxy (i.e. we represent Him in all matters of life; we are there in place of Him). We are His ambassador, representing Heaven on earth with His power. (2 Cor 5:20)

B. Living in Christ.

- 1. Lifestyle of Faith.
 - a) Living in faith by using the Name of Jesus.
 - b) Mar 11:23 For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say (specific incident one time) unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he says (ongoing basis lifestyle) shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he says (one time specific incident).
 - c) You can have what you say; you can do anything; create your world the way you want it.
- 2. Lifestyle of Anointing.
 - a) Living in the anointing (i.e., in the Anointed One and His anointing). Joh 15:7 If ye abide in me, and my words abide in you, ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done unto you.
 - Php 4:13 I can do all things through Christ which strengthens me.
 - b) The anointing changes us totally from the inside out (spirit, heart, soul, mind and body, words and works).
 - c) The anointing changes our flesh.



Rom 8:11 But if the Spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the dead **dwells in you**, he that raised up Christ from the dead shall also **quicken your mortal bodies** by his Spirit that dwells in you.

d) The anointing changes our words.

Matt 12:34 For out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaks.

You can do anything, so create your world the way you desire it.

e) The anointing requires commitment and discipline. Examples are Mark Spitz, Michael Phelps and William Seymour.

C. Dwelling in Him.

- 1. More Scriptures.
 - a) By Him.

Acts 3:16 The faith which is **by him** has given him this perfect soundness in your presence. Act 13:39 And by him all that believe are justified from all things.

1Co 1:5 That in every thing ye are enriched by him, in all utterance, and in all knowledge.

Col 1:16 For by him were all things created, that are in heaven, and that are in earth, visible and invisible, whether they be thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or powers: all things were created by him, and for him.

Col 1:17 And he is before all things, and by him all things consist.

Col 3:17 And whatsoever ye do in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God and the Father by him.

Heb 7:25 Wherefore he is able also to save them to the uttermost that come unto God by him, seeing he ever liveth to make intercession for them.

Heb 13:15 By him therefore let us offer the sacrifice of praise to God continually, that is, the fruit of our lips giving thanks to his name.

b) Through Him.

Act 10:43 To him give all the prophets witness, that through his name whosoever believeth in him shall receive remission of sins.

Rom 5:9 Much more then, being now justified by his blood, we shall be saved from wrath through him.

Rom 8:37 Nay, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him that loved us. Eph 2:18 For through him we both have access by one Spirit unto the Father.

1Jn 4:9 In this was manifested the love of God toward us, because that God sent his only begotten Son into the world, that we might live through him.

c) With Him.

Rom 6:4 We are buried with him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life.

Rom 6:6 Knowing this, that our old man is crucified with him, that the body of sin might be destroyed, that henceforth we should not serve sin.

Rom 6:8 Now if we be dead with Christ, we believe that we shall also live with him.

Rom 8:32 He that spared not his own Son, but delivered him up for us all, how shall he not with him also freely give us all things?

Col 2:12 Buried with him in baptism, wherein also ye are risen with him through the faith of the operation of God, who hath raised him from the dead.

Col 2:13 And you, being dead in your sins and the uncircumcision of your flesh, hath he quickened together with him, having forgiven you all trespasses.

1Th 4:14 For if we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so them also which sleep in Jesus will God bring with him.
