

Blessed Are the Pure In Heart

Overview: Mat 5:8 Blessed are the pure in heart: for they shall see God.

A. My Personal Story

Rev 3:20 Behold, I stand at the door, and knock: if any man hear my voice, and open the door, I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with me.

Pro 22:11 He who loves **purity** and the **pure** in heart and who is gracious in speech--because of the grace of his lips will he have the king for his friend. **AMPC**

PU'RITY, n. [L. puritas, form purus.] (in Websters Dictionary)

- 1. Freedom from foreign admixture or heterogeneous matter; as the purity of water, of wine, of spirit; the purity of drugs; the purity of metals.
- 2. Cleanness; freedom from foulness or dirt; as the purity of a garment.

The purity of a linen vesture.

- 3. Freedom from guilt or the defilement of sin; innocence; as purity of heart or life.
- 4. Chastity; freedom from contamination by illicit sexual connection.
- 5. Freedom from any sinister or improper views; as the purity of motives or designs.
- 6. Freedom from foreign idioms, from barbarous or improper words or phrases; as purity of style or language.

Rom 8:14 For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, these are sons of God.

Joh 14:21 He who has My commandments and keeps them, it is he who loves Me. And he who loves Me will be loved by My Father, and I will love him and manifest Myself to him."

Exo 24:7 Then he took the Book of the Covenant and read in the hearing of the people. And they said, "All that the LORD has said we will do, and be **obedient**."

Deu 8:20 As the nations which the LORD destroys before you, so you shall perish, because you would not be **obedient** to the voice of the LORD your God.

Isa 1:19 If you are willing and **obedient**, You shall eat the good of the land;

Psa 119:9 How can young people keep their lives **pure**? By **obeying** your commands.

Php 2:8 And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself and became **obedient** to *the point of* death, even the death of the cross.

B. Be Pure and Righteous

Job 8:6 Then, if you are **pure** and upright, surely He will bestir Himself for you and make your **righteous** dwelling prosperous again.

Job 25:4 Can anyone be righteous or pure in God's sight? GNB

Psa 119:7 As I learn your righteous judgments, I will praise you with a pure heart. GNB

2Co 6:6 By our **purity**, knowledge, patience, and kindness we have shown ourselves to be God's servants---by the Holy Spirit, by our true love,

2Co 6:7 by our message of truth, and by the power of God. We have **righteousness** as our weapon, both to attack and to defend ourselves. **GNB**

Rom 3:25 whom God set forth *as* a propitiation by His blood, through faith, to demonstrate His **righteousness**, because in His forbearance God had passed over the sins that were previously committed,

Rom 5:17 For if by the one man's offense death reigned through the one, much more those who receive abundance of grace and of the gift of **righteousness** will reign in life through the One, Jesus Christ.)

Rom 8:10 And if Christ is in you, the body is dead because of sin, but the Spirit is life because of **righteousness.**



Rom 10:10 For with the heart one believes unto **righteousness**, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.

Rom 14:17 for the kingdom of God is not eating and drinking, but **righteousness** and peace and joy in the Holy Spirit.

2Co 5:21 For He made Him who knew no sin *to be* sin for us, that we might become the **righteousness** of God in Him.

Mat 6:33 But seek first the kingdom of God and His **righteousness**, and all these things shall be added to you.

C. See the Face of Jesus

Hos 5:15 I will return again to My place Till they acknowledge their offense. Then they will seek My **face**; In their affliction they will earnestly seek Me."

Luk 9:29 As He prayed, the appearance of His **face** was altered, and His robe *became* white *and* glistening.

2Co 4:6 For it is the God who commanded light to shine out of darkness, who has shone in our hearts to *give* the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the **face** of Jesus Christ.

Rev 22:4 They shall see His face, and His name shall be on their foreheads.

Rev 22:12 "And behold, I am coming quickly, and My reward *is* with Me, to give to every one according to his work.

Rev 22:13 I am the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End, the First and the Last."

Rev 22:16 "I, Jesus, have sent My angel to testify to you these things in the

churches. I am the Root and the Offspring of David, the Bright and Morning Star."

Rev 22:17 And the Spirit and the bride say, "Come!" And let him who hears say, "Come!" And let him who thirsts come. Whoever desires, let him take the water of life freely.

Isa 11:10 "And in that day there shall be a Root of Jesse, Who shall stand as a banner to the people; For the Gentiles shall **seek Him**, And His resting place shall be glorious."

Heb 11:6 But without faith *it is* impossible to please *Him*, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and *that* He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him.

Mar 11:24 Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye **desire**, when ye pray, believe that ye receive *them*, and ye shall have *them*.
