Foundation Scriptures:

Mat 5:18 For verily I say unto you, Till heaven and earth pass, one jot or one tittle shall in no wise pass from the law, till all be fulfilled.

- A. Overview God's Word is true.
 - 1. Failure in the Garden of Eden.
 - a) The Promise.
 - Gen 2:15 The LORD God took the man, and put him into the garden of Eden to dress it and to keep it.
 - Gen 2:16 And the LORD God commanded the man, saying, Of every tree of the garden thou may freely eat:
 - b) The Choice.
 - Gen 2:17 But of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, thou shall not eat of it: for in the day that thou eat thereof thou shall surely die.
 - c) The Result.
 - Gen 3:22 And the LORD God said, Behold, the man is become as one of us, to know good and evil: and now, lest he put forth his hand, and take also of the tree of life, and eat, and live for ever:
 - 2. Success for us.
 - a) The Promise: Pro 15:4a A wholesome tongue is a tree of life.
 - b) The Choice: Pro 18:21 Death and **life** are in the power of the tongue:
 - c) The Result: Rev 2:7 He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; To him that overcomes will I give to eat of the tree of life, which is in the midst of the paradise of God.
- B. Partnerships through Covenant.
 - 1. Covenants in the O.T.
 - a) Blessings have been commanded to chase down the obedient.
 - Deu 28:1 It shall come to pass, if thou shall hearken diligently unto the voice of the LORD thy God, to observe and to do all his commandments which I command thee this day, that the LORD thy God will set thee on high above all nations of the earth:
 - Deu 28:2 And all these blessings shall come on thee, and overtake thee, if thou shall hearken unto the voice of the LORD thy God.
 - b) More blessings come to those who are both obedient and willing.
 - Isa 1:19 If ye be willing and obedient, ye shall eat the good of the land:
 - c) Success always comes from doing things God's way.
 - Psa 1:1 Blessed is the man that walketh not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor standeth in the way of sinners, nor sitteth in the seat of the scornful. v1:2 But his delight is in the law of the LORD; and in his law doth he meditate day and night. v1:3 And he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that bringeth forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither; and whatsoever he doeth shall prosper.
 - Jos 1:8 This book of the law shall not depart out of thy mouth; but thou shall meditate therein day and night, that thou may observe to do according to all that is written therein: for then thou shall make thy way prosperous, and then thou shall have good success.
 - 2. Covenants in the N.T.
 - a) All things come through hearing and doing.
 - Mar 11:24 Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them.



- Mar 11:25 And when ye stand praying, forgive, if ye have ought against any: that your Father also which is in heaven may forgive you your trespasses.
- Mar 11:26 But if ye do not forgive, neither will your Father which is in heaven forgive your trespasses.
- b) Salvation comes through hearing and doing
 - Rom 10:9 That if thou shall confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shall believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shall be saved.
 - 1Ti 2:4 God, Who will have all men to be saved, and to come unto the knowledge of the truth.
 - Act 2:21 whosoever shall call on the name of the Lord shall be saved
- c) Grace comes through hearing and doing
 - Eph 2:8 For by grace are ye saved **through faith**; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God:
 - 2Pe 1:2 Grace and peace be **multiplied** unto you through the knowledge of God, and of Jesus our Lord.

C. Two Types of Believers

Rev 1:3 Blessed is he that **readeth**, and they that **hear** the words of this prophecy, and **keep** those things which are written therein: for the time is at hand.

- 1. Your choice to be blessed.
 - a) Choose with your heart and words.
 - Deu 30:19 I call heaven and earth to record this day against you, that I have set before you life and death, blessing and cursing: therefore choose life, that both thou and thy seed may live:
 - b) Choose with your obedient actions.
 - Mat 7:24 Therefore whosoever heareth these sayings of mine, and doeth them, I will liken him unto a wise man, which built his house upon a rock:
 - Mat 7:25 And the rain descended, and the floods came, and the winds blew, and beat upon that house; and it fell not: for it was founded upon a rock.
 - c) Choose with your lifestyle.
 - Heb 5:13 For every one that uses **milk** is unskilful in the word of righteousness: for he is a babe.
 - Heb 5:14 But **strong meat** belongs to them that are of full age, even those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil.
 - Jn 8:31 Said Jesus to those Jews which believed on him, If ye continue in my word, then are ye my disciples indeed; v32 and ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free.

2. Empowerment.

"Blessed" means empowered to prosper.

- a) Blessing of the Book of Revelation.
 - **Continue** in the Book of Revelation to be empowered to prosper during the circumstances of the Ending Days.
- b) Aaronic Blessing.
 - Num 6:24 The LORD bless thee, and keep (*protect*) thee: v25 The LORD make his face shine upon thee, & be gracious (*full of grace*) unto thee: v26 The LORD lift up his countenance upon thee, and give thee peace (*shalom nothing missing, nothing broken*).
- c) Rapture.
 - 1Th 4:16 For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first:
 - 1Th 4:17 Then we which are alive and **remain** shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord.
