

Mothers of the Ending Days

Overview: Using biblical examples as patterns, create a lifestyle where you are building an Ark of Anointing for all those in your sphere of influence. Acts 16:31.

Rev 21:7 He that overcometh shall inherit all things; and I will be his God, and he shall be my son.

3. Building your End-Time Ark

a) Your behavior

- 1) What you think.
 - a. Visualize yourself living an overcoming lifestyle. Rev 2:7,11,17,26; Rev 3:5,12,21; Rev 21:7
 - c. Be aware that you are the example for your family.
 - d. Picture yourself as a God chaser.

b. Keep your mind focused on Jesus.

- e. Practice being in the presence of the Holy, Holy, Lord God Almighty.
- 2) What you pray.
 - a. When you are short on time
 - Pray the ABC Morning Prayer: See Part 3, a), 2), c [which is part c right below]. In the NOJ, I declare over me, my family and friends this day all the promises of Ps 23 and Ps 91; and that, in the NOJ, God would multiply in us this day all the blessings of Eph 1:17-23, Eph 3:14-21, Col 1:9-11
 - b. Frequently during the day. 1 John 1:9 (Call 119)
 Heavenly Father, in the Name of Jesus (NOJ), I am not aware of any sins since the last time that I confessed, so please cleanse me of all unrighteousness. I receive my forgiveness and, in the NOJ, I invite the Spirit of God to fall fresh on me. In the NOJ, I bind up every demon, devil and evil spirit around me or in my home, and I cast them out of the state. In the NOJ, I re-establish the KOG in my home and around me. Amen.

c. ABC Morning Prayer: as led by the Holy Spirit pray for yourself, family and friends. In the NOJ, I loose into my life and the life of my family and friends this day God's will, power and angels, and I bind from us this day satan and all his devils, demons and evil spirits.

Heavenly Father, in the NOJ, I forgive the sins of all members of my family. In the NOJ, I pray that the Spirit of God will fall fresh on them. In the NOJ, I bind up every demon, devil and evil spirit around them or in their homes and I cast them out of the state. In the NOJ, I re-establish the KOG in their homes and around them. Amen.

- 3) What you say.
 - a. Speak the Word of God always and you will always have what you say. Mark 11:23
 - b. Speak only words which bring grace to the hearer.

Eph 4:29

c. Remember you are justified by the words of your mouth.

Matt 12:37

- 4) What you do.
 - a. Worship God in truth, living your day as one of rejoicing in God. Jn 4:23-24; Phil 4:4
 - b. Worship God in truth by letting your day consist totally of executing Faith Action Plans (FAP), one after another.

b) Your relationships

- 1) Praying for your family and friends.
 - a. Refer to S1D5P18 Introduction to Spiritual Warfare for Your Family.
 - b. Forgive them their sins.

John 20:23

- 2) Setting your example.
 - a. Be a loving and forgiving person.

1 John 4:16; Matt 6:12; Mark 11:2

- b. Be the one to whom they come for prayer and healing.
- 3) Esteeming them greater than yourself.

Phil 2:3

a. Turning the other cheek.

Matt 5:39

b. Be a giver and a forgiver.

c) Living in the KOG.

- 1) Establishing the KOG.
 - a. Confess sins often, RRB, C/O, declare God's will & power around you & in your home.
- 2) Stay in the KOG.
 - a. Monitor your joy, peace and patience; if decreasing, then do re-establish the KOG.
- 3) Live with the Spirit of God upon you.
 - a. After confessing sins, invite the Spirit of God to fall afresh upon you
 - b. Declare from Isa 61:1 & 2. (adapted and personalized)
 - Isa 61:1 In the Name of Jesus, the Spirit of the Lord GOD [is] upon me; because the LORD hath anointed me to preach good tidings unto the meek; he hath sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to [them that are] bound;
 - Isa 61:2 To proclaim the acceptable year (*i.e.*, the year of Jubilee) of the LORD, and the **day of vengeance** of our God; to comfort all that mourn.
 - c. Declare from Isa 11:2 & 3 (adapted and personalized)
 - Is a 11:2 In the Name of Jesus, the spirit of the LORD is upon me, the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and might, the spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the LORD;
 - Isa 11:3 making me of quick understanding in the fear of the LORD, and of all the circumstances of life so that and I shall not judge after the sight of my eyes, neither reprove after the hearing of my ears:
