

Chapter 20: The Millennium

Foundation Scriptures

Rom 8:11 But if the Spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, he that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by his Spirit that dwelleth in you.

1Co 15:45 And so it is written, The first man Adam was made a living soul; the last Adam [was made] a quickening spirit.

1 Co 15:45AMPC

Thus it is written, The first man Adam became a living being (an individual personality); the last Adam (Christ) became a life-giving Spirit [restoring the dead to life].

Rom 8:30 Moreover whom he did predestinate, them he also called: and whom he called, them he also justified: and whom he justified, them he also glorified.

A. Satan bound for 1000 years

Rev 20:1 And I saw an angel come down from heaven, having the key of the bottomless pit and a great chain in his hand.

Rev 20:2 And he laid hold on the dragon, that old serpent, which is the Devil, and Satan, and bound him a thousand years,

Rev 20:3 And cast him into the bottomless pit, and shut him up, and set a seal upon him, that he should deceive the nations no more, till the thousand years should be fulfilled: and after that he must be loosed a little season.

Rev 12:9 And the great dragon was cast out, that old serpent, called the Devil, and Satan, which deceiveeth the whole world: he was cast out into the earth, and his angels were cast out with him. Joh 8:44 Ye are of [your] father the devil, and the lusts of your father ye will do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaketh a lie, he speaketh of his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it.

B. Thrones

Rev 20:4 **And I saw thrones, and they sat upon them**, and judgment was given unto them: and [I saw] the souls of them that were beheaded for the witness of Jesus, and for the word of God, and which had not worshipped the beast, neither his image, neither had received [his] mark upon their foreheads, or in their hands; and they lived and reigned with Christ a thousand years.

Rev 20:5 <u>But the rest of the dead lived not again until the thousand years were finished</u>. This [is] the first resurrection.

Rev 20:6 **Blessed and holy [is] he that hath part in the first resurrection**: on such the second death hath no power, but they shall be priests of God and of Christ, and shall reign with him a thousand years.

Rev 3:21 To him that overcometh will I grant to sit with me in my throne, even as I also overcame, and am set down with my Father in his throne.

Joh 11:21 Then said Martha unto Jesus, Lord, if thou hadst been here, my brother had not died.

Joh 11:22 But I know, that even now, whatsoever thou wilt ask of God, God will give [it] thee.

Joh 11:23 Jesus saith unto her, Thy brother shall rise again.

Joh 11:24 Martha saith unto him, I know that **he shall rise again in the resurrection** at the last day.



Joh 11:25 Jesus said unto her, I am the resurrection, and the life: he that believeth in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live:

Joh 11:26 And whosoever liveth and believeth in me shall never die. Believest thou this?

Other groups which are likely to remain after Armageddon are:

- Believers who are alive and did not remain true to the Full Gospel but have not taken the mark of the beast (e.g., those in the Ark of Anointing).
- Unbelievers who have not taken the mark of the beast. Possibly, these will have the opportunity to accept Jesus as Savior and Lord.
- Unbelievers who did take the mark of the beast but did not participate in the Armageddon. These will be destroyed with the Sword of the Spirit as in v 19:21.

C. Gog and Magog

Rev 20:7 And when the thousand years are expired, Satan shall be loosed out of his prison,

Rev 20:8 And shall go out to deceive the nations which are in the four quarters of the earth, Gog and Magog, to gather them together to battle: the number of whom [is] as the sand of the sea.

Rev 20:9 And they went up on the breadth of the earth, and compassed the camp of the saints about, and the beloved city: and fire came down from God out of heaven, and devoured them.

Rev 20:10 And the devil that deceived them was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone, where the beast and the false prophet [are], and shall be tormented day and night for ever and ever.

a) Two Events of Judgment

- (1) The return of the Son of Man to purge the earth of sinners
 - Coming of the Lord
 - 1Th 4:15 For this we say unto you by the word of the Lord, that we which are alive [and] remain unto the <u>coming of the Lord</u> shall not prevent them which are asleep. Jam 5:8 Be ye also patient; stablish your hearts: for the <u>coming of the Lord</u> draweth nigh.
 - The time when the Son of Man cometh
 - Mat 24:44 Therefore be ye also ready: for in such an hour as ye think not the Son of man cometh.
 - Mat 25:13 Watch therefore, for ye know neither the day nor the hour wherein the Son of man cometh.
 - Luk 12:40 Be ye therefore ready also: for the Son of man cometh at an hour when ye think not.
 - Luk 18:8 I tell you that he will avenge them speedily. Nevertheless when the Son of man cometh, shall he find faith on the earth?
 - Luk 21:36 Watch ye therefore, and pray always, that ye may be accounted worthy to escape all these things that shall come to pass, and to stand before the Son of man.
 - Other names are:
 - Day of the Lord (29x), Great Day of the Lord (1x)



- (2) The purging of the earth by fire, resulting in a new heaven and earth
 - Day of the Lord

2Pe 3:10 But the <u>day of the Lord</u> will come as a thief in the night; in the which the heavens shall pass away with a great noise, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat, the earth also and the works that are therein shall be burned up.

2Pe 3:11 [Seeing] then [that] all these things shall be dissolved, what manner [of persons] ought ye to be in [all] holy conversation and godliness,

2Pe 3:12 Looking for and hasting unto the <u>coming of the day of God</u>, wherein the heavens being on fire shall be dissolved, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat?

Great Day of God

Zep 1:14 The great day of the LORD [is] near, [it is] near, and hasteth greatly, [even] the voice of the day of the LORD: the mighty man shall cry there bitterly. Zep 1:15 That day [is] a day of wrath, a day of trouble and distress, a day of wasteness and desolation, a day of darkness and gloominess, a day of clouds and thick darkness.

- b) Other Names
 - Day of Judgment (8x)
 - Day of Wrath (4x)
 - Day of God (2x)
 - The Last Day

D. Great White Throne Judgment

Rev 20:11 And I saw a great white throne, and him that sat on it, from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away; and there was found no place for them.

Rev 20:12 And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is [the book] of life: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works. Rev 20:13 And the sea gave up the dead which were in it; and death and hell delivered up the dead which were in them: and they were judged every man according to their works.

Rev 20:14 And death and hell were cast into the lake of fire. This is the <u>second death.</u>
Rev 20:15 And <u>whosoever was not found written in the book of life</u> was cast into the lake of fire.

- a) Who are the dead standing before God?
 - Rev 20:5 But the rest of the dead lived not again until the thousand years were finished. This [is] the first resurrection.
- b) Unpardonable Sin
 - **1Jo 5:16** If any man see his brother sin a sin [which is] not unto death, he shall ask, and he shall give him life for them that sin not unto death. There is a sin unto death: I do not say that he shall pray for it.
 - Heb 6:4 For [it is] impossible for those who were once enlightened, and have tasted of the heavenly gift, and were made partakers of the Holy Ghost,
 - Heb 6:5 And have tasted the good word of God, and the powers of the world to come,
 - Heb 6:6 If they shall fall away, to renew them again unto repentance; seeing they crucify to themselves the Son of God afresh, and put [him] to an open shame.
 - **Heb 10:23** Let us hold fast the profession of [our] faith without wavering; (for he [is] faithful that promised;)



Heb 10:24 And let us consider one another to provoke unto love and to good works:

Heb 10:25 Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some [is]; but exhorting [one another]: and so much the more, <u>as ye see the day approaching</u>.

Heb 10:26 For if we sin wilfully after that we have received the knowledge of the truth, there remaineth no more sacrifice for sins,

Heb 10:27 But a certain fearful looking for of judgment and fiery indignation, which shall devour the adversaries.

Heb 10:28 He that despised Moses' law died without mercy under two or three witnesses: Heb 10:29 Of how much sorer punishment, suppose ye, shall he be thought worthy, who hath trodden under foot the Son of God, and hath counted the blood of the covenant, wherewith he was sanctified, an unholy thing, and hath done despite unto the Spirit of grace?
