

Faith is NOT walking by sight

Undergraduate Healing School Theme:

Jas 4:7 Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.

Foundation Scripture: 2 Cor 5:7 (For we walk by faith, not by sight:)

- A. Living by Faith.
 - Total commitment of your life to Jesus. Heb 612 AMPC In order that you may not grow disinterested and become [spiritual] sluggards, but imitators, behaving as do those who through faith (by their leaning of the entire personality on God in Christ in absolute trust and confidence in His power, wisdom, and goodness) and by practice of patient endurance and waiting are [now] inheriting the promises.
 - 2. All your actions must be based on the Word. Heb 11:1 AMPC Now faith is the assurance (the confirmation, the **title deed**) of the things [we] hope for, being the proof of things [we] do not see and the conviction of their reality [faith perceiving as real fact what is not revealed to the senses].
 - 3. The Essence of Faith.

Your faith is the leaning of your entire **being** on God in Christ in absolute trust and confidence in His **Word**, power, wisdom, and goodness.

Your faith is the title deed to whatever you desire of the promises in the Word.

B. Healing by not walking by sight.

1. The Word is all you need.

Joh 1:1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and **the Word was God**. Joh 1:14 And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth.

Psa 107:20 **He sent his word,** and healed them, and delivered [them] from their destructions. 1Pe 2:24 Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes ye were healed.

2. Look at the Word.

2Co 4:18 While we look not at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen: for the things which are seen [are] temporal; but the things which are not seen [are] eternal. Rom 4:20 He staggered not at the promise of God through unbelief; but was strong in faith, giving glory to God;

Rom 4:21 And being fully persuaded that, what he had promised, he was able also to perform. 2Ti 1:12 For the which cause I also suffer these things: nevertheless I am not ashamed: for I know whom I have **believed**, and am **persuaded** that he is **able to keep** that which I have committed unto him against that day.

3. Speak the Word.

Rom 4:17 (As it is written, I have made thee a father of many nations,) before him whom he believed, [even] God, who quickeneth the dead, and **calleth those things which be not as though they were.**

Rom 4:18 Who against hope believed in hope, that he might become the father of many nations, according to that which was spoken, So shall thy seed be.

Rom 4:19 And being not weak in faith, he considered not his own body now dead, when he was about an hundred years old, neither yet the deadness of Sara's womb:
