## **Protection Prayer Series – God Protects Believers**

A. Do Not Be Afraid; Only Believe.

Mark 5:35, 36 -43

- 1. Do not be "afraid" transliterates in the Greek as G5399"phobeo" which means do not "fear" or do not be scared away.
- 2. Merriam-Webster defines "afraid" as "filled with fear."
- 3. "Believe" transliterates in the Greek as G4100 "pisteuo" which means "commit to (one's) trust.
- 4. Merriam- Webster defines "believe" as:
  - a) To have a firm or wholehearted religious conviction or persuasion: to regard the existence of God as a fact. Do you believe? usually used with in believe in the Scriptures.
  - b) To accept something as true, genuine, or real ideals we believe in believes in ghosts.
  - c) To have a firm conviction as to the goodness, efficacy, or ability of something believe in exercise.
- 5. If you truly believe in your heart that God has answered your prayer, when you asked one time, you should be a hear and doer to act on it, and speak or affirm it out loud, because in the spirit realm it has already been done for you.
- B. Pray Effect Prayers.
  - 1. The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much. James 5:16b
- C. Pray and affirm a Scripture That God Has Promised You.

Ezek 12:25, Isa 55:11, Jer 1:12

- D. God Wants to Protect Believers.
  - 1. The Lord will fight for you.

Exodus 14:13-14

- a) <sup>13</sup> Moses said to the people, "Do not be afraid. Stand still, and see the salvation of the Lord, which He will accomplish for you today. For the Egyptians whom you see today, you shall see again no more forever. <sup>14</sup> The Lord will fight for you, and you shall hold your peace.
- 2. The Lord delivers you from trouble.

Psalm 34:19

- a) Many are the afflictions of the righteous, but the Lord delivers him out of them all.
- 3. The Lord will not forsake you.

2 Corinthians 4:8-9

- a) <sup>8</sup> We are hard-pressed on every side, yet not crushed; we are perplexed, but not in despair; <sup>9</sup> persecuted, but not forsaken; struck down, but not destroyed.
- 4. The Lord will be our refuge and protect us.

Psalm 91

- a) Pray Psalm 91 every day upon awakening without fail.
- b) It is strongly suggested to memorize it by heart.



## Psalm 91 Protection Prayer (Personalized) NKJV

## <u>Heavenly Father, in the name of Jesus,</u> I pray, for myself (and for my family, friends and loved ones) that daily:

<sup>1</sup>I (we) dwell in the secret place of the Most High (and) I (we) abide under the shadow of the Almighty.

<sup>2</sup>I (we) say of the Lord, "You are my (our) refuge and my (our) fortress; My (Our) God, in You I (we) trust."

<sup>3</sup>Surely You deliver me (us) from the snare of the fowler and from the perilous pestilence.

<sup>4</sup>You cover me (us) with Your feathers, and under Your wings I (we) take refuge; Your truth is my (our) shield and buckler.

<sup>5</sup>I (*We*) am (*are*) not afraid of the terror by night, nor of the arrow that flies by day,

<sup>6</sup>Nor of the pestilence that walks in darkness, nor of the destruction that lays waste at noonday.

<sup>7</sup>A thousand may fall at my (*our*) side, and ten thousand at my (*our*) right hand;

but it shall not come near me (*us*).

<sup>8</sup>Only with my (our) eyes shall I (we) look, (Only a spectator shall I (we) be myself (ourselves) inaccessible in the secret place of the Most High {AMPV}), and see the reward (or punishment {NIV}) of the wicked,

<sup>9</sup>Because I (*we*) have made the Lord, who is my (*our*) refuge, even the Most High, my (*our*) dwelling place,

<sup>10</sup>No evil shall befall me (*us*), nor shall any plague come near my (*our*) dwelling;

<sup>11</sup>For You have given Your angels charge over me (us), to keep me (us) (to accompany, defend and preserve me (us) {AMPC}) in all my (our) ways (in obedience and service {AMPC}, to protect {TLB}).

<sup>12</sup>In their hands they bear me (us) up,

lest (to prevent that) I (we) dash my (our) foot against a stone (or stumble {H5062}).

 $^{13}\mathrm{I}\;(\mathit{We})$  tread upon the lion and the cobra, the young lion and the serpent I  $(\mathit{we})$  trample underfoot.

<sup>14</sup>Because I (we) have set my (our) love upon You (Lord), therefore You (God) deliver me (us);

You set me (us) on high (that You will put me/us up too high that I/we cannot be captured by the enemy {H7632}),

because I (we) know Your name (my/our Lord, Jesus Christ),

(and I (we) have a personal knowledge of Your mercy, love, and kindness —

I (we) trust and rely on You, knowing You will never forsake me (us) {AMPC}).

<sup>15</sup>I (We) call upon You (Heavenly Father), and You answer me (us);

You (Holy Spirit) are (always) with me (us) in trouble;

You (Lord, Jesus) deliver me (us) and honor (and promote {H3513}) me (us).

16 With long life You (God) satisfy me (us), and show me (us) Your salvation.
