

## Spiritual Axioms

### Webster's Definition of an Axiom:

- 1) A maxim (*i.e.*, *fundamental principle*) widely accepted on its intrinsic merit.
- 2) A proposition regarded as a self-evident truth.
- 3) ABC's definition: a principle generally accepted as a law.

#### A. Laws.

A law is a statement of order or relation of phenomena that is invariable under given conditions. (*i.e.*, a cause and effect which cannot change).

1. Legal - man made laws.
2. Physical - scientific laws of nature which supersedes the legal.
3. Spiritual - highest laws which supersedes all others.

#### B. Axioms of Productivity.

1. God helps those who help themselves.

You add works to your faith to bring the manifestation.

2. God will only do for you what is impossible for you.

God gave you free will.

God will not over-ride your choice.

If you choose **not** to do something that you can do, God will respect that decision. 1 Tim 2:4

Now **if you cannot do something** that you desire to do, then God can help you without contradicting your will.

3. You are your own worst enemy.

God said choose life or death, blessing or cursing.

Deut 30:19

Satan comes to steal, kill and destroy.

John 10:10

Only you can cause you to partner with the devil.

Jm 4:7

If you partner with God, then you choose life and blessings and the promises.

#### C. Axioms of Creativity.

1. On this earth, every spiritual effect has a physical affect. This means that the physical is the cause and the spiritual is the result (*i.e.*, the effect).
