

A Lifestyle of Faith

1. The Foundation is Trusting God.

1Jo 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us [our] sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

Pro 3:5 Trust in the LORD with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding. v 3:6 In all thy ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths.

Isa 26:4 Trust ye in the LORD for ever: for in the LORD JEHOVAH [is] everlasting strength:

Hab 3:19 AMPC God is my strength, my personal bravery and my invincible army.

Mat 18:18 Verily I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.

Recommendation: In the Name of Jesus, loose into your life daily God's will, His power and His angels; and bind from you daily satan and all his demons, devils and evil spirits.

2. Trust Your Prayers.

Mar 11:22 And Jesus answering saith unto them, Have faith in God. Young's Literal Translation – Have faith of God.

Mar 11:24 Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive [them], and ye shall have [them].

Phi 4:6 Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God.

Phi 4:7 And the peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.

Isa 26:3 Thou wilt keep [him] in perfect peace, [whose] mind [is] stayed [on thee]: because he trusteth in thee.

Mar 11:25 And when ye stand praying, forgive, if ye have ought against any: that your Father also which is in heaven may forgive you your trespasses.

Mar 11:26 But if ye do not forgive, neither will your Father which is in heaven forgive your trespasses.

Mat 18:33 Shouldest not thou also have had compassion on thy fellowservant, even as I had pity on thee?

Mat 18:34 And his lord was wroth, and delivered him to the tormentors, till he should pay all that was due unto him.

Mat 18:35 So likewise shall my heavenly Father do also unto you, if ye from your hearts forgive not every one his brother their trespasses.

Recommendation: Be a loving, forgiving person. Forgive from your heart in the Name of Jesus.



3. Trust Your Words.

Pro 18:21 Death and life [are] in the power of the tongue: and they that love it shall eat the fruit thereof.

Pro 12:14 A man shall be satisfied with good by the fruit of [his] mouth: and the recompence of a man's hands shall be rendered unto him.

Pro 13:2 A man shall eat good by the fruit of [his] mouth: but the soul of the transgressors [shall eat] violence.

Pro 13:3 He that keepeth his mouth keepeth his life: [but] he that openeth wide his lips shall have destruction.

Mar 11:23 For verily I say (G3004) unto you, That whosoever shall say (G2036) unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall **not doubt in his heart**, but shall believe that those things which he saith (G3004) shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith (G2036)

G3004 Say as a systematic or set discourse (i.e. as a lifestyle habit).

G2036 A definite individual expression of saying.

Recommendation: Affirm frequently that in the Name of Jesus, God has made the words of your mouth and the meditations of your heart pleasing to Him. Ps 19:14

4. Trust Your Authority.

Joh 14:14 If ye shall ask (G154) any thing in my name, I will do [it].

G4441 defines G154 as "asking strictly as a demand for something due.."

Mar 16:17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;

Mar 16:18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.

Mat 10:8 Heal the sick, cleanse the lepers, raise the dead, cast out devils: freely ye have received, freely give.

Luk 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.

Phi 2:9 Wherefore God also hath highly exalted him, and given him a name which is above every name:

Phi 2:10 That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of [things] in heaven, and [things] in earth, and [things] under the earth;

Rom 8:17 And if children, then heirs; heirs of God, and joint-heirs with Christ.

1 Cor 2:16. You have the mind of Christ.

Recommendation: Think, speak and act as an adult in the family of God.
