

The Five Deadliest Mistakes

Overview: Jesus took all of our sins and purchased us with His Blood so that we can live daily in Jubilee, remaining under the anointing in the Kingdom of God. All the blessings of God belong to us. We are joint heirs with Jesus but we fail to dwell in the promises because we continue to fall short of God's Glory. The main reasons why we fail to manifest the promises are the Five Deadliest Mistakes.

A. Mistake #1 is not confessing your sins.

1. 1 John 1:9 If you confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive you *[your]* sins, and to cleanse you from all unrighteousness.
2. Confession is not asking for forgiveness. Forgiveness already belongs to you. Confession is agreeing with God that you have been disobedient to His Word.
3. Components of sin..
Affects your fellowship with God, your relationships, your body and opens the door for the devil to attack you.
2 Tm 2:26 And *[that]* they may recover themselves out of the snare of the devil, who are taken captive by him at his will.
Wipe away the spiritual cobwebs, the snares of the devil.
4. 2 Tm 2:26 And *[that]* they may recover themselves out of the snare of the devil, who are taken captive by him at his will.

B. Mistake #2 is not forgiving all others.

1. Jesus had 3 great teachings on prayer, which took 30 verses.
2. Of the 30 verses, 20 were on the importance of forgiving and the negative impact of not forgiving from your heart.
3. God forgave you all sins; should you not forgive the few sins committed against you by others?
4. Mat 18:34 And his lord was wroth, and delivered him to the **tormentors**, till he should pay all that was due unto him.
Mat 18:35 So likewise shall my heavenly Father do also unto you, if ye from your hearts forgive not every one his brother their trespasses.

C. Mistake #3 is not understanding the Prayer of Faith.

1. Prayer of Faith.
Jam 5:15 And the **prayer of faith** shall save the sick, and the Lord shall raise him up; and if he have committed sins, they shall be forgiven him.
Jam 5:16 Confess *[your]* faults one to another, and pray one for another, that ye may be healed. The **effectual fervent prayer** of a righteous man availeth much.
2. Mark 11:24 has three conditions.
Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye **desire**, when ye **pray**, **believe that ye receive** *[them]*, and ye shall have *[them]*.
3. Faith in your heart
Mar 11:23 For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and **shall not doubt in his heart**, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith
Faith in your heart is believing that you receive when you pray. Spiritually, you see it finished as Jesus did when on the cross He said, "It is finished." in John 19:30; and then again via His angel to the apostle John, "It is done." concerning Armageddon in Rev 16:17.

4. Spiritual warfare through the Sword of the Spirit – The Prayer of Affirmation.
Pro 23:7 For as he thinketh in his heart, so [is] he. If you believe in your heart, then you will speak and act on what you believe, that your prayer has been answered; and create a Faith Action Plan to use it (or manifest it). In fact, if you believe in your heart, you will do your best to get rid of any hindrances or blockages which are preventing its manifestation. Thus we affirm as spiritual warfare to remove the demons and their lies of doubt, unbelief and fear.

You are the “healed of the Lord” and you use the Prayer of Affirmations to wage war against the enemies who want to steal your healing. You live by faith, by the belief in your heart, not by what you see nor sense with your five senses and body.

- D. Mistake #4 is not understanding the limitations of God’s sovereignty.
 1. Mar 13:31 Heaven and earth shall pass away: but my words shall not pass away.
God’s Word cannot fail. God can do anything but He cannot break His word.
 2. God cannot do for you what He has told you to do
He has given you authority over the earth and all that moves upon it. He has told you to heal the sick and cast our demons. You should not be asking Him to do it.
 3. God has given you free will so He cannot over-ride your will, your decision.
It is the will of God that all be saved but people can choose to go to hell.
People can choose a sinful or unhealthy life style; God will not stop them.
God is not in charge of your life today unless you have put Him in charge of it today.
 4. Partnership with God.
2 Pet 1:3 God has already given you everything you need for life and godliness. When you ask for what He has already given to you, then you are saying you did not believe His Word and since your faith is based on His Word, then at best you introduce doubt and fear into your prayers; at worst, you cancel them.
1 Pet 2:24 You have been healed by the stripes of Jesus. Do you believe it in your heart or not? Whose report shall you believe?
- E. Mistake #5 is not speaking God’s Word.
 1. Speak Christianese.
Jesus only said what the Father said.
Eph 4:29 Your words should bring grace to the hearer.
 2. Matt 12:37 You are justified by the Words of Your mouth.
 3. Jam 3:8 The tongue is an unruly evil which no man can control; full of deadly poison.
It must be controlled by the Holy Spirit.
Ps 19:14 In the Name of Jesus, God has made the words of my mouth and the meditations of my heart pleasing to Him.
Pray in tongues a lot. Do many affirmations.
 4. Not speaking God’s Word results in the evil of the tongue canceling your prayers, allowing the devil to attack you; and speaking curses over yourself and others.
Pro 10:19 In the multitude of words there wanteth not sin: but he that refraineth his lips [is] wise.
Pro 18:8 The words of a talebearer [are] as wounds, and they go down into the innermost parts of the belly.
Pro 18:20 A man’s belly shall be satisfied with the fruit of his mouth; [and] with the increase of his lips shall he be filled. Pro 18:21 Death and life [are] in the power of the tongue: and they that love it shall eat the fruit thereof.
