# The Anointing for Healing

Overview: God is life and in His presence is that life changing force, which caused Moses to glow and which is described as fullness of joy in Ps 16:11; and the light of that life drives out all darkness including demons, devils, evil spirits, sickness, diseases and death.

The manifestation of this light is called the anointing, which is the presence of the Holy Spirit manifested for a specific purpose. That purpose can be determined by what you speak. Therefore, you should be determined to keep increasing the time you spend with God and to be always speaking words of health and healing.

# A. What is the Anointing?

- 1. Definitions of Anointing.
  - a) Webster: anoint is (1) to smear or rub; by inference, anointing is that which is smeared or rubbed. (2) to apply oil as a sacred rite, especially for consecration.

	b) Hebrew: Shemen - Grease, richness, ointment (e.g., anointing oil).	Ex 30:31-33
	c) Greek: Chrisma - Also translated as "unction."	1 John 2:20
2.	God's Anointing Process	
	a) The presence of the Holy Spirit, manifested for a purpose e.g., burning bush	Ex 3:3-4
	b) The Spirit of the Lord was moving upon the face of the waters.	Gen 1:2
	c) The Holy Ghost shall come upon Mary (Lk 1:35); the Word was made flesh.	John 1:14

3. The anointing can be visibly seen as a glory cloud or a pillar of fire. Ex 13:21 4. The anointing changes you spiritually (Ex 24:16-18) and physically. Ex 34:28-33

5. As Jesus was teaching, the power of the Lord was present to heal them. Luke 5:17

6. The anointing destroys (obliterates) the yoke of bondage Isa 10:27 by confirming the Word when it is spoken in faith out of a heart of faith.
